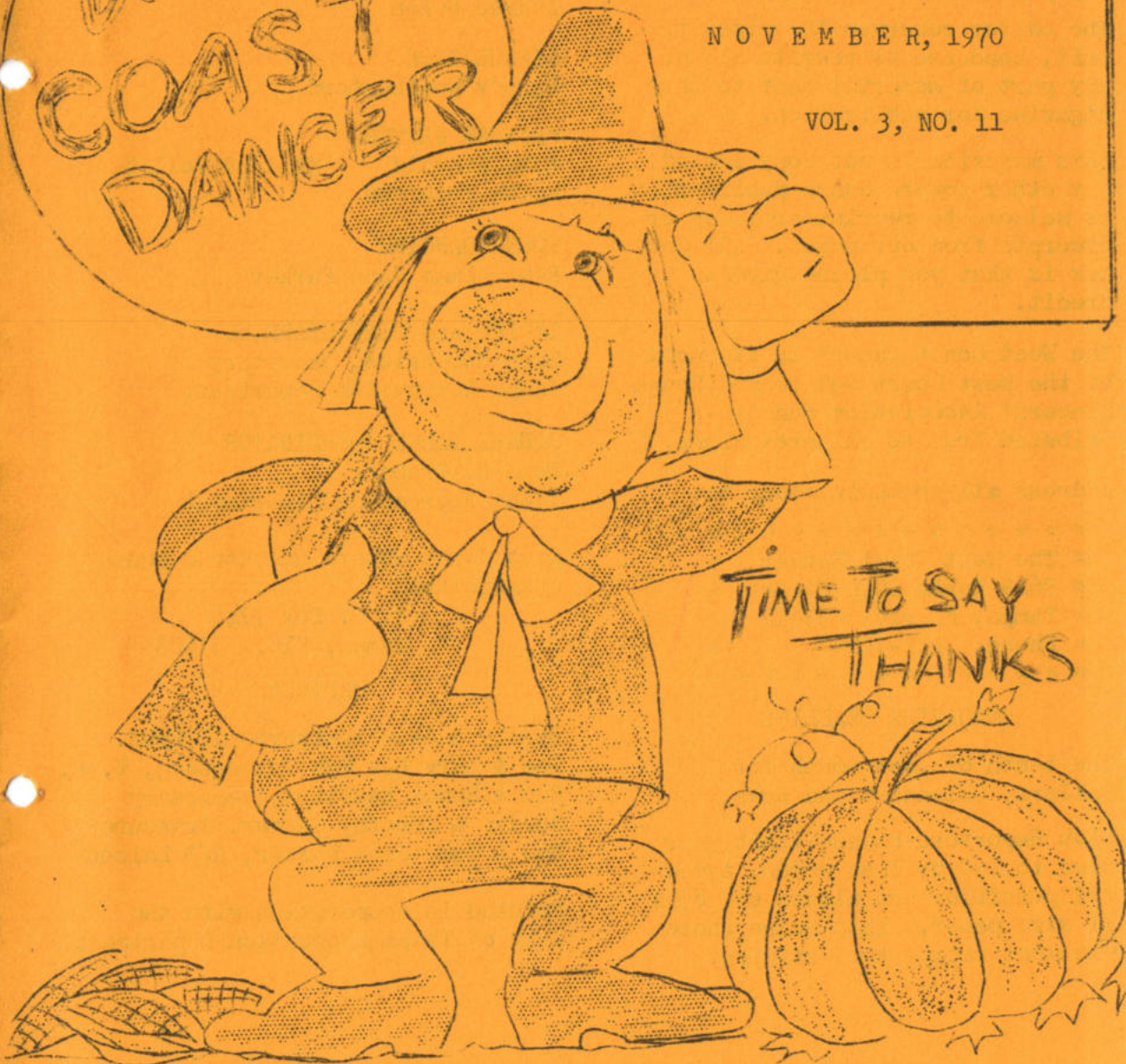

TABLE TALK

HERMITS COOKIES

- 1/2 C Vegetable Shortening
- 1 C Brown Sugar "packed"
- 2 Eggs
- 2 C Seeded Chopped Raisins
- 2 C Sifted Cake Flour
- 1/2 C Chopped Nuts
- 1 t Cinnamon
- 1/4 t Cloves
- 1/4 t Nutmeg
- 2 t Baking Powder
- 1/2 t Salt

Cream shortening, add sugar and eggs one at a time. Beat well until light, add sifted dry ingredients, raisins and nuts, mix well. Drop by teaspoon onto greased cookie sheet. Bake in moderate oven (350 degrees) about 10 minutes.

DATE COOKIES

- 1 C Chopped Dates (8-oz. pkg.)
- 1 Stick Butter or Oleo
- 3/4 C Sugar

Put above ingredients in heavy skillet and mix well over slow heat, add 2-slightly beaten eggs and cook over slow heat 10 minutes, (Be sure mixture is not too hot) and stir eggs into mixture as quickly as is possible to keep whites from cooking too fast. The secret is not to cook the mixture too fast after the eggs have been added. Remove from heat, add

- 1 C Chopped Pecans
- 1 t Vanilla
- 2 C Rice Krispies

Mix and cool slightly and form mixture into balls and roll in "Angel Flake Coconut." Makes approximately 50 small cookies.
