INFLATION

No matter how tired you are of hearing about it, inflation is the "buzz" word for today's living. Everyone is concerned about the price of gas, food, and entertainment. Where it will stop no one knows. We in the Square Dance World have tried to hold prices down with a lot more success than anyone else. Where else can you go and have 2½ to 3 hours of fun for \$1.50?

We must be realistic, however, our dances have been hit with price increases in many clubs where dances which are breaking even now, are going to go in the red. Several clubs have folded and some halls have already closed. The caller's equipment which cost \$1,200 a couple of years ago is now \$2,000. Records which used to be \$2.00 are now \$3.00 and everything else has gone up. Callers may have to have a raise in many clubs just to make expenses. These are the big things, let's look at the small things too. Coffee, tea, cups, forks, plates, ice etc. have gone up. With this in mind we must look at our activity and determine if we are paying a fair price at the door. Most of the state is paying \$1.00 - \$1.50 a person at club dances and \$2.00 - \$2.50 for special dances. We need to look at each situation to see if we need to go up in price. It has been suggested that \$1.75 would be a fair price however \$2.00 has been suggested since it would take care of some future increases in cost. Each club must determine the price within which they can operate without loss or fear of closing. Let us have your ideas and suggestions. We will print as space permits.

SAUSAGE CASSEROLE
