UNIVERSAL ROUND DANCE COUNCIL

HOVER CROSS seems to be one of the most abused figures particularly noticeable at festivals attended by all levels of round dancers. We'd like to quote from the URDC ROUND DANCE MANUAL AND ENCYCLOPEDIA the proper execution of a HOVER CROSS as approved by the URDC:

"The HOVER CROSS is used in waltz and foxtrot and uses two measures. The figure is started with a R ft lead for M (L W) either in a closed, contra banjo or semi-closed position facing any direction. (generally it is started facing DW). The first 3 steps are almost identical to the natural closedtelemark or for an identity without the heel turn consider a cross pivot to SCAR in the first 3 steps. The heel turn for the woman provided a much smoother action for the couple and is used in this description. It it is started in a SCP the woman would not make a heel turn and would step forward short step and turn with the man to SCAR."
