87 STATE CONVENTION DRESS

Broad Cloth (Palencia)
2 1/2 - 3 yds. Main Color
3/4 - 1 yd. Rainbow Colors

COLORS:

- Light Pink
- Wistoria (lavander)
- Daffodil
- Sweet Blue
- Lime (Golden Strand, Greenwood mills).

Can be bought at most Cloth Worlds, T G & Ys and Zayres.

The Measurements are for a size 12
22" length, Adjust accordingly.

You can Mix and Match Neckline with sleeves. Puff, Tulip or Cape.

Style #4: This could be made into a skirt and blouse easily.



Style #2

Dimensions for skirt -- 8 gore skirt with inserts, lower side of inserts 4 1/2", wide side of inserts 15". Use your favorite gore skirt pattern.

Bodice and upper part of gored skirt, sleeves and belt of the color of your choice. With the bottom inserts of skirt, ruffles around neckline and bottom of Puff sleeve the remaining 4 colors.

Suggest making 3 1/2" wide strips 7" long for the ruffles.

LADIES:

Petticoat same color as main part of dress with multi color petti pants. Suggest White shoes.

Petti Pants--N-20 Malco Mode (Multi Color)


MENS:

Shirt same color as main part of dress with contrasting Tie, Towel to match tie. White Pants, belt and shoes.

SHIRTS:

- Pink --- Rockmont 677 or H bar C laws
- Yellow --- Niver by Mesquite WPL 6472
- Green --- Rockmont 650
- Lavander --- Niver by Mesquite 400-3 or Rockmont 670
- Blue --- H bar C (A little different shade)
