

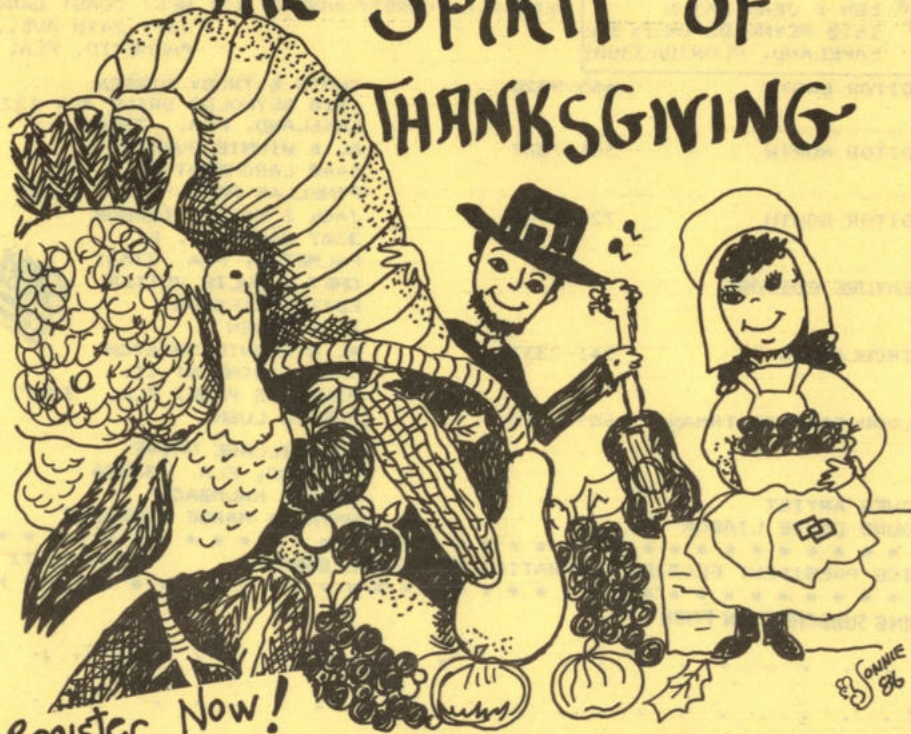

**CHINESE TUNA** serves 4

1 5 oz. can Chow Mein noodles	1/2 cup chopped celery
1 can Cream of Mushroom soup	1 8 oz. can Tuna
1/4 cup water	1/2 cup chopped onion
1 8 oz. can water chestnuts	

Take 1/2 cup noodles out and set aside. Mix remaining ingredients with the rest of the noodles. Pour into a casserole dish and top with reserved noodles. Bake uncovered for 30 minutes in 325° oven.
