Those who attended the After Party skits are still laughing about the hilarious three act play presented by the Kallers & Kuers. They discovered that Art Springer has hidden talent.

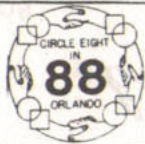
No one has more fun than a Knothead. Even the astonished security guards had fun learning how to yellow rock.
