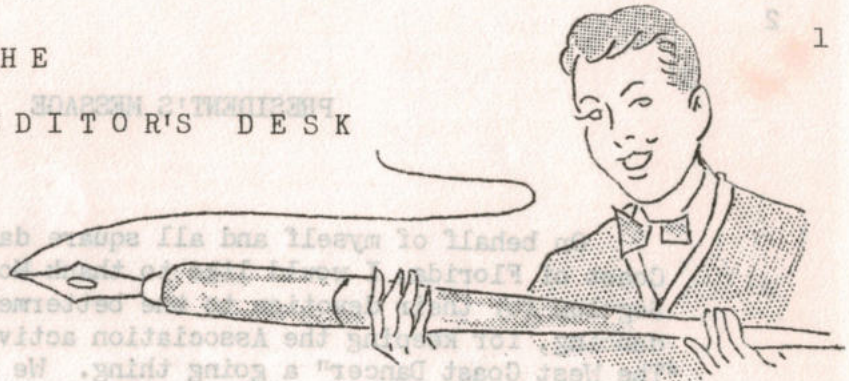

EDITOR'S DESK





TABLE TALK

CASSEROLE "Chicken"

- 1-Chicken
- 2-Boxes Broccoli (frozen)
- 2-Cans Cream of Chicken Soup
- 1-C Mayonnaise
- 1-Pkg. Cheddar Cheese (sharp) cut in small pieces
- 1-C "Pepperidge" Crumbs
- Grease 9 x 13 x 2 Pyrex dish

Stew chicken, cook broccoli and drain. Put broccoli in bottom of dish, then cover with bite size pieces of chicken. Mix cream of chicken soup and mayonnaise and pour over top of chicken. Put "Pepperidge" crumbs on top. Top with cheese. Bake in 350 degree oven for 25 to 30 minutes, serve.

BAKED Chicken

- 4-thighs, 4-legs and 2-breasts (cut in half) you may add 4-wings (optional)
- Mix enough flour, salt and paprika in a paper bag to flour each piece of chicken.
- Melt 1/2 lb. butter or oleo in a large flat pan.
- Add 4-T Worcestershire sauce and stir through butter.
- Place each floured piece of chicken in pan and push chicken pieces through butter mixture until thoroughly coated.
- Place chicken pieces (skin side) down in pan and arrange same in the pan.
- Bake in oven at 400 degrees for one hour, turning chicken pieces every 20 minutes. SERVE
