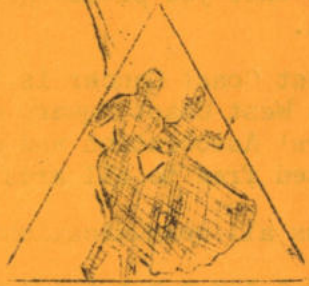

TABLE TALK

LEMON COCOANUT SQUARES

- 1 C Flour Mix and pat into 8 x 13" pan. Bake light brown,
- 3 T Sugar about 10 minutes at 350 degrees.
- 1/2 C Butter
- 2 Beaten Eggs 1/4 t. Salt
- 2 T Flour 1 C Sugar
- 1/2 C Cocoanut 1 C Chopped Nuts
- 1 t. Sugar 1 t. Baking Powder

Combine and spread on baked crust, bake 20 min. at 350 degrees. Frost with 1-C powdered sugar, 1-T. butter. Rind and juice of 1 lemon. Spread on cookies when cooled, cut into bars or squares. "NOTE" If lemon is very juicy 1/2 lemon may be enough, use with water so frosting will pour.

COMPANY CASSEROLE

- 4 C Broad Noodles (1/2-lb.) 1 T Butter
- 1 lb. Ground Chuck 2 8 oz. Cans Tomato Sauce
- 1/2 lb. Cottage Cheese (1-C.) 1 pkg. (8-oz.) Cream Cheese
- 1/4 C Sour Cream 2 T Melted Butter
- 1/3 C Minced Green Onions & Tops
- 1 T Minced Green Pepper

Cook noodles, drain. Pour melted butter over noodles immediately. In butter in skillet, saute chuck until browned. Stir in tomato sauce. Remove from heat. Combine cottage cheese and next 4 ingredients, (soft cream cheese) (sour cream) (minced green onions and tops) (minced green pepper). In 2-quart casserole, spread half of noodles; cover with cheese mixture, then cover with rest of noodles. Pour tomato meat sauce on top. Make this preparation early in the day and refrigerate. About 1 hour before serving, heat oven to 350 degrees, bake 45 minutes. Will serve 4.
