Pistachio Supreme Dessert

1cup flour, 2teas. sugar, 1stick margarine, 1/4cup nuts (reserve a few for top of dessert). Press into greased 9X13 pan (or you can use a 9 inch square) Bake 15 min. at 375 degrees. Don't let it get to brown. Cool. Beat together 8oz. softened cream cheese and 2/3 cup sifted powdered sugar. Fold in half carton Cool Whip. Spread over baked layer. refrigerate until chilled. Beat until thick: 2 pkgs. Pistachio pudding (lemon instant is also good) Spread over Cool Whip layer. Mix rest of Cool Whip with nuts left over from the first layer. Spread over top. OVER THE YEARS IN TEXT AND LECTURE THE CALLERS TAW HAS BEEN PROTRAYED IN MANY WAYS. SHE HAS BEEN RECOGNIZED AS THE PERSON RESPONSIALE FOR HER HUSBAND'S SUCCESS AS A CALLER AND THEN AGAIN AS THE UNDERLYING CAUSE OF HIS RUIN.. SHE IS COMPLIMENTED AND MOST OFTEN CRITICIZED.

JUST WHAT IS HER ROLE? LIKE MANY OF THE ROLES WOMEN FIND THEMSELVES PLAYING IN TODAY'S SOCIETY THAT OF A CALLER'S TAW IS ONE FOR WHICH SHE RECEIVES NO TRAINING. SHE BECOMES A CALLERS TAW BECAUSE HE LIKE ( OR WANTS TO CALL)... NOT BECAUSE SHE HAS THE PERSONALITY, THE CHARACTERISTIES OR THE DESIRE TO BE ONE. NOTICE I KEEP SAYING CALLER'S TAW RATHER THAN WIFE; AT HOME YOUR'RE HIS WIFE, AT THE DANCE YOU FILL ANOTHER ROLE NOT NECESSARILY A WIFELY ONE, BUT ONE THAT HAS BEEN CREATED BY PUBLIC OPINION AND EXPECTATION.

HOW IMPORTANT IS SHE TO SQUARE DANCING IN GENERAL? SHE MUST SET A GOOD EXAMPLE BY BEING UNDERSTANDING - SHARING - RESPONSIBLE - FRIENDLY - HELPLER(WITHOUT DISRUPTING ) - POISED- DEMONSTRATOR OF DANCES - CHARMING - GRACEFUL - BEAUTIFULLY DRESSED - HOSTESS AND AN ADVISOR ON S,UAERE DANCE ETIQUETTE AND ON TOP OF THIS SHE MUST CONVINCCE THE DANCERS THAT S,UAERE DANCING IS FUN.

WHAT IS HER ROLE TO HER CALLER-SPOUSE IN PARTICULAR? IT IS HER GREATEST RESPONSIBILITY TO SUPPORT AND ENCOURAGE HER HUSBAND TO THE FULLEST. HER ROLE INCLUDES BEING A BOOKING AGENT - SECRETARY - TRAVELING HOUSEKEEPER - PUBLIC RELATIONS AGENT - SOUND JUDGER - PROGRAM PLANNER (FOR SPECIAL EVENTS, SKITS, & ETC.) - EVALUATOR OF HIS PEREORMANCE AS A TEACHER AND AS A CALLER (TO BE A CRITIC ONLY WHEN NECESSARY) - SEES TO IT THAT HE TAKES OFF FOR A DANCE IN PLENTY OF TIME WITH A CAR FILLED WITH GAS - HAVING HIS MEALS READY AND HIS CLOTHS WAITING - AND TO CREATE A PLEASANT ATMOSPHERE SO WHEN HE TAKES HIS MICROPHONE IN HAND HE WILL CALL A GREAT DANCE.

WHEN WE GO OVER ALL THE THINGS A TAW MUST BE , SHE WOULD HAVE TO BE A SUPER, SUPER WOMAN TO ACHIEVE ALL THAT IS REQUIRED EVERY TIME HER HUSBAND GOES TO CALL. BUT ONE CAN LOOK AT ONESELF AND PICK OUT THE GOOD QUALITIES THAT SHE HAS AND BY USING THOSE AND WORKING ON THE OTHER THINGS SHE WILL ACCOMPLISH MUCH.

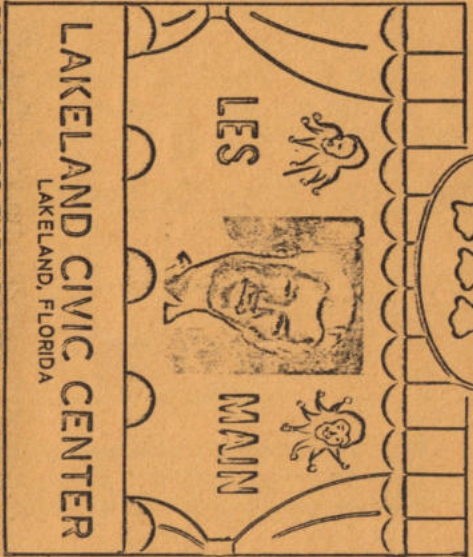
