### 1980 FLORIDA STATE CONVENTION REPORT



Alan & Bertha Ashcroft and the Southeast Area convention committee are not only to be congratulated for mounting a first class convention, but also for producing such a financial success. Mr Ashcroft reports that there were 3579 persons in attendance in Lakeland, 3154 of which were registered and 2431 paid participants. The profit was \$10,334.38 which is the largest return ever from a Florida state convention.

These proceeds were divided as follows: \$1033 to the host association and \$3100 to each of the sponsoring organizations, the Florida Federation of Square Dancers, the Florida Callers Association and the Round Dance Council. A further division of the Florida Federation's share will be 1/3 or \$1033 additional to the host association (S.E. Square & Round Dance Association). All of these funds are dedicated to the promotion of square and round dancing here in the sunshine state

### REFLECTIONS ON KNOTHEAD

Once again the Knothead Kommittee provided a fun filled weekend for dancers from all over Florida. 2031 dancers enjoyed the kalling of Dave Taylor and Kip Garvey doing squares with Bill & Irene Morrison on rounds. They were aided and abetted by various members of the kommittee. Attendance was off some 200 from 1979 but this was expected due to economic conditions. Knothead serves as a first big konvention for many new dancers who have recently graduated. As such the trails-in dance was a bit high level, however this was rectified on Saturday and Sunday.

DEVELOPING ROUND DANCE STANDARDS

In view of the urgent need for standards and the study of basics for round dancing, we researched how other activities develop standards and found the best and most satisfactory method is to establish a board of experts that have had many years of experience and training to evaluate, study and develop the proper written instructions for each item to be used in the activity. In view of round dancing's national and international growth, it was apparent such a board for round dancing must represent all areas of America. From this study, 21 couples were asked to help in this task. These couples represent about 375 teaching years, which certainly brings together the thinking of some of the best in the activity. This does not mean that these couples are the only ones with these qualifications as there are many others, but the demands of time, postage, phone calls, etc., needed to make a logical and workable program set our limits of participation.

This 21-couple Technical Advisory Board has worked great over the last five years and a good deal has been accomplished in the development and release of the U.R.D.C. R/D Encyclopedia & Reference Manual as it is now in print. New and additional pages are constantly in the works and will be released as they are completed.

Now to explain how each basic or R/D procedure is handled with the board: First, the coordinating office, together with other board members, will research and compile all the data pertaining to the item being considered. From this, a sample write-up is made and sent to each board member couple. They then study and evaluate the sample written instructions. After two days to two weeks they will write out their comments and send them to the coordinating office. The coordinating office compiles all replies and makes any adjustments that are needed. If major suggested changes are made, the sample write-up is changed and resubmitted to the members for their evaluation of the change. By this method each couple can study the item thoroughly, try it out, research any detail they desire and make a good report of their study.

This eliminates endless, nonproductive discussions at meetings and provides the valuable thinking of 42 highly qualified leaders who are giving of their time and energy for the benefit of round dancing.

- 2 cups flour
- 2 cups sugar
- 1 Tblsp. cinnamon
- 2 tsps. baking soda
- 1 tsp. baking powder
- 1 tsp. salt
- 1 cup oil
- 2 tsp. vanilla
- 3 eggs
- 2 cups zucchini, chopped
- 1 cup raisins
- 1 1/2 cups nuts

Put in greased pan (9 x 13)

Bake about 1 hour at 350°
