NATIONAL FOLK DANCE COMMITTEE

On June 28, 1984 a hearing of the Subcommittee on Census & Population of the U.S. House of Representatives was held in Washington D.C. for the purpose of gathering testimony on HR 1706 which would designate the square dance as the National Folk Dance of the U.S.A. Chairwoman Katie Hall was the only committee member present.

Pro testimony was heard from Cathie Burdick, Bob Osgood, George F. Holser, Congressman Mineta, Congressman Panetta and others. Testifying against the resolution were Ralph Rinzler and Dr. Thomas Vennum of the Smithsonian Institute; Dr. Charles Camp, State Folklore of the Maryland Arts Council and others. 12 interested parties, including Bob Van Antwerp, Joe & Joy Vaccari and Frank & Nan Habersberger, submitted written testimony in favor of the resolution.

Those attending the hearing felt that the "DECK" was stacked against the resolution. However there are 266 co-sponsors including all 5 members of the subcommittee and 19 of the 25 members of the full Post Office and Civil Service Committee.

The main concern now is that little time remains for action to be taken on HR 1706 before the full house adjourns. All anyone can do now is send letters and telegrams to Chairman Ford requesting "Mark Up" for HR 1706 and for the bill to be sent to the house floor for a vote.

Frank & Nan Habersberger of the S.E. Association have devoted untold hours to this cause as representatives of the Florida Federation of Square Dancers and they deserve our gratitude for their efforts and dedication.

He began his calling career in Baltimore, Md. and was a member of the SDLBA there. He moved to the West Coast of Florida in 1973. He was instrumental in bringing square dancing to the popularity it is now. In his clubs a dancer could start instructions and progress all the way through to high level. He also taught round dancing and coached new callers.

In later years, Chuck underwent chemotherapy for Hodgkins disease and had open heart surgery after a heart attack in 1981.

Chuck leaves behind a daughter, Mary Beth, and three grandchildren. He will be missed by his many friends and square dancers.

The family and friends of Chuck Kessler wish to thank all who came to the Memorial Service at Stirling Hall on August 18th, and who contributed to the Memorial Fund in an effort to finalize his financial affairs.
