How quickly their enthusiasm can be cut short. How? Easily- If your calendar and schedules are wrong. There is nothing more frustrating to a new dancer than to go to your class---and find the hall closed and dark. Why?---The date, place, or time of the class or dance is wrong.

Why not take the time if you are a caller, cuer, or club president to carefully check your information in the Dancer for accuracy.

If, you spot an error do not call, write or holler!! Instead, fill out the correction slip that was sent with your copies of the Dancer, and forward to the editors, or to your area vice-president prior to the first of the month for correction.

WHEN YOU GET THE CORRECTION FORM, SAVE ONE SO IF YOU DON'T HAVE ONE, YOU CAN USE A PLAIN SLIP AND FOLLOW THE FORMAT OF THE CORRECTION FORM. WHICH IS ADDITION, DELETION, CHANGE, ROUNDS, CALENDAR, WORKSHOP, ETC THEN THE DAY, CITY, AREA, EVENT AND FINISH WITH THE CALLER. ALSO SPACE YOUR CORRECTION SO THEY CAN BE CUT APART INTO SEPARATE SLIPS TO BE PUT INTO THEIR APPROPRIATE SLOTS FOR THE COMPUTER.

Remember, we are human and do make mistakes. Please work with us, follow the procedure for changes and help us give you a better West Coast Dancer magazine.
