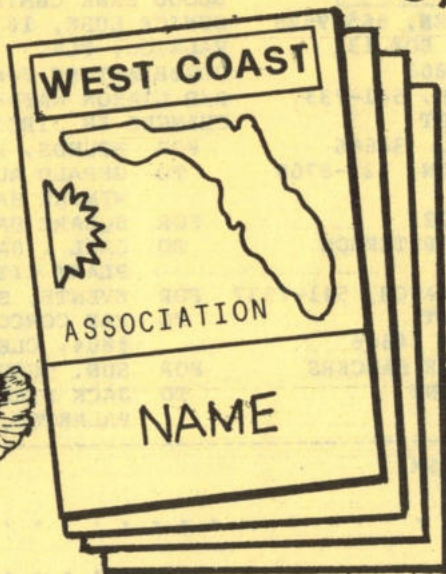

DID YOU KNOW? All blood center processing fees for blood and blood components transfused in Community Blood Bank's service area will be covered for donors and their dependents for members under the annual Life Plan. Processing fees will be paid at hospitals in the following counties: Pinellas, Pasco, Hernando, Hillsborough and Manatee.

BANK

A blood center processing fee is the fee charged for donor recruitment, blood collection, testing, storage, and distribution. Specific fees vary depending on type of blood component. Coverage does not apply to the hospital's charges associated with transfusions, such as "typing/crossmatch" and "transfusion" fees.

Individuals who donate one unit of blood annually provide themselves and their IRS dependents one year's exemption from blood processing fees at hospitals in the blood center's service area. Are you a participating member?

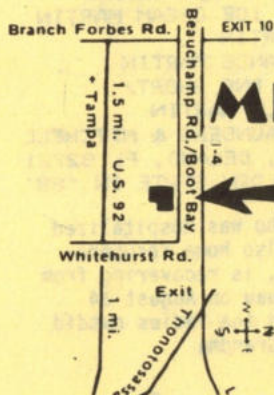

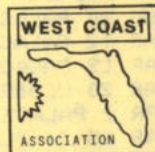
