## A TRIBUTE TO JEAN FULTZ

APRIL 20, 1915 TO MARCH 3, 1997

Born in Monongalia County, West Virginia April 20, 1915, Jean and husband Hugh moved to Concord, Ohio where Hugh was employed as District Engineer of Ohio Bell Telephone Company and Jean pursued a career of teaching. They retired to St. Petersburg, Florida in 1973. They immediately became active in the square dance community. They worked as Editors of the West Coast Dancer for a period of five years, resigning the position in September 1982. They progressed through the chairs of the West Coast Square and Round Dancers' Association, culminating with the position of President during the 1977 - 1978 season. They held the office of President of the Left Allamanders for two terms - 1983-1984 and 1984-1985. They served as General Chairman for the Florida State Square and Round Dance Convention. The theme for the convention was "Star Through in 82" and Jean personally crocheted the stars for the ladies outfits. She wished to put "stars into the eyes of all dancers". After their term they continued to travel in support of the Association. They were among the initial recipients of the Circle of Service Award in 1985. They accepted a commitment to the Florida Federation of Square Dancers. After the death of Hugh, March 1, 1986, Jean continued her support of the activity, and completed their term of office as Federation Presidents 1986-1987. The Fultz have been honored with a well deserved space in the Florida Square Dance Hall of Fame located at Strawberry Square, Plant City. An honor known as the Hugh and Jean Fultz award is presented to members of the Left Allamanders for outstanding service.

This issue is devoted in part to the presidents who have served in the office for the West Coast Square and Round Dancers' Association and we felt the Memorial would be an excellent opening statement.
