Sincere sympathy is extended to her husband, Frank, her family and friends. She will be greatly missed by all who knew her.

OLDEST SQUARE DANCE CLUB A PIECE OF LIVING HISTORY

First they moved the trucks out of the utility company's garage and steam-cleaned the floor. Then they loaded a piano onto a flatbed truck and moved it inside. Next they moved in another flatbed for the band. Finally they "squared up" for the dance.

Those square dancers first took the floor in the Colorado Public Service Company's garage in Denver in 1939. Now, more than 58 years later, the club, known as the Kilowatt Eights, is still dancing. Last summer American Square Dance Magazine certified the 60 member club as the nation's oldest.

Wilbur and Ima Harr, elected in 1950 as the club's first formal presidents, are still active dancers. They remember when the club danced every Friday night, with the women in floor-length dresses, petticoats and pantaloons. Music was always live - sometimes just a piano or an accordion.



Some years the club was down to one square, and caller Charlie Tuffield and his wife despaired. But the club survived. Members attribute the club's longevity to good callers, good food, perseverance and members being a "good bunch of friendly people"

Now skirts are shorter, petticoats fuller and the music recorded, but the fun and fellowship of square dancing remain.
