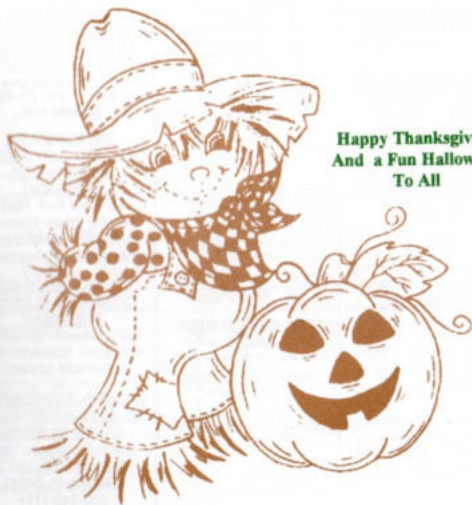

Planning for the 48th Florida Square and Round Dance Convention (24, 25, 26 May 2002) is moving ahead. The organizers of the 2002 convention met in Tallahassee on 28 July to discuss progress and firm up plans for activities at the convention. Ticket sales for the 2002 convention are approaching 500. Discount tickets are available for \$16 through 31 October.

Activities discussed at the meeting included the theme for the fashion show and a "Red, White and Blue" night at the 2002 convention. Sources tell me that traditionally dancers wear the state colors on Friday night and their club colors on Saturday. That leaves Sunday night for "Red, White and Blue". 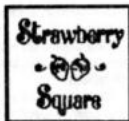

There are presently 32 states that have passed Legislation for "Square Dancing" as their state folk dance including Florida. This definition includes: Square, Round, Contra, Clogging, Line, Country and Western, Ethnic, Polka, and Heritage dancing.

## RECRUITING AND YOU

*This is a continuation of the response Ann & Don Stocum received to their request for ideas on recruiting and maintaining dancers. It was from Karin Strickland.*

### IDEA Number 4

It seems that the idea of church groups is especially attractive for square dancing, because generally they don't drink but still want to have social activities where they can meet, socialize, etc. Maybe churches could be contacted with this idea (of having groups come out to dances, or for demos, or for an "invitation" to one time have their Youth or Senior group "come to the club" so they can see how it all works). Remember that most church groups are looking for activities for their members which are fun, friendly and 'clean'. If you organize with churches for church dances with other dancers, you can teach a little, maybe do some line dancing, and show a little square dancing and maybe get people hooked. They aren't going to like it if they never try it or even KNOW about it!

There are a lot of church groups that probably never even THOUGHT to try square dancing, yet it's fun and wholesome. It would be so nice to get people of all ethnic groups involved in square dancing - maybe some of the ethnic churches could be talked to to try to set up some sort of dance or lessons or maybe an event where the dancers get together with the church group to try to get them interested? Has a special effort ever been made to reach out to minorities? It would be so wonderful!

### IDEA Number 5

Along the same lines, what about the schools? I'm not sure of the correct way to do this, BUT the ACBL was particularly successful when they went into the schools. They had members go into the schools and teach and play bridge with the kids. The school children loved it and it was interesting and fun.

One problem with bringing dancing to the schools is that you often hear that adults were "turned off to dancing as kids because of the way that it was introduced. You were "forced" with the opposite sex before you were ready. "Girls had cooties" and your friends made fun of you "Fred likes Ginger", etc. In those years, it was presented to kids

almost like a punishment and it really turned people off to square dancing and sometimes all dancing years later.

So it's REALLY important that this is done correctly. You should "survey" school kids - ask THEM how they would LIKE to have square dancing taught? The TV channel Nickelodeon actually did this; they ASKED kids what they would LIKE their "kids' channel" to be. Then they took those answers and "designed" it around the kids' desires. With bridge, they tried to find out how the kids WANTED to learn. Then, bridge players VOLUNTEERED to go into the schools and do the lessons and play with the kids. Make it FREE to the schools, of course, with volunteers. I would suggest the same thing with Square Dancing. TALK TO the kids, find out what THEY would like, make THEM comfortable. Design the program around the answers - make it FUN!

Then CALLERS and even Angels can VOLUNTEER to go into the schools once a week and teach! New, good, young dancers.

This is especially good for high school or junior high, where the kids want to do fast things, want to have fun, want to mingle with the opposite sex. Although admittedly it may be better to at least try to introduce at the grade school level so that they are at least "used to it"; that is, unless they are SO against 'touching' or doing something with 'yucky girls' that it would just upset them.

### IDEA Number 6

Has there ever been a "square dancing night" at some of the Western Clubs? There are a few Western dance clubs down here in South Florida, I don't know if this is common in the rest of the state. Maybe once a week (or once a month) you could have a caller take the evening (every Tuesday night: Square Dance night). Maybe they could intersperse square dancing with some line dancing and have some square dancers there as kind of a "demo". Possibly the caller would be there just for a while OR there all evening calling tips interspersed with lines. It may generate some interest in square dancing (hey, that looks like fun). And of course you would give info on how to take lessons, come to a club, maybe come to Bring a Friend Event, etc. (As an interesting side note, this Western Club idea actually came from my chiropractor.)

#### IDEA Number 7

Speaking further about cross pollination: Dancers do other things besides dance! I play bridge, for example. Why not have flyers for beginning lessons printed up and ask dancers to distribute them at their bridge clubs, churches, condos, stores, golf courses, anywhere else that they are interested. After all, if you have dancers who play bridge, other bridge players might be interested in dancing too, right?

#### IDEA Number 8

Of course, an obvious idea is advertising. HOWEVER, I believe this has been done inappropriately in the past. The problem is that the advertising needs to be "appropriately targeted". You would want to target the "correct" places, and that's the key; not the big papers (such as the Miami Herald) - your ad would be LOST there - and in general I don't think you will get response from a Miami Herald ad for square dancing, for example. You must target small, specialized papers (like the Jewish Journal, the Senior News, other papers that go to the senior condos for FREE); also the little local "hometown" papers; the "Parklander", the "Coral Springs News", etc.

#### IDEA Number 8A

How about a "One FREE lesson" coupon in the "Pennysaver" or the "Coral Springs News", for example?
