GAY & LESBIAN SQUARE DANCE CLUBS

Over the last 25 years, square-dancing clubs started by and for gays and lesbians have sprouted in major cities around the country and around the world. Many participants do not have a background in dance, much less the intricacies of square dancing, and some are not homosexual. They are drawn to the clubs by a friendly social environment, the opportunity to learn something new and the sheer fun of "peeling the top" and "cutting the diamond".

It wasn't until the dawn of the AIDS crisis that square dancing grew in popularity within the gay community. Same-sex square dancing was an offshoot of the gay rodeo circuit, which had started as an alternative to traditional rodeos, where homosexual cowboys were not welcomed. In the late 1970s and early 1980s, as gay men saw their friends become infected with HIV, some sought social scenes that were not oriented around alcohol and sex. Those who were drawn to the communal aspect of square dancing sometimes encountered straight people who did not wish to dance with them, whether out of simple prejudice or for fear of contracting AIDS.

In contrast to straight square-dancing groups, gay groups tend to be less formal. In most traditional groups, women must wear skirts and crinolines, while men must wear crinolines - sleeved shirts. Also, everyone is expected to have a partner. While gay clubs are more casual regarding attire and roles (boys and girls may reverse their role in the dance) they hold dancers to the standards set forth by Callerlab for Modern Western square dancing.

The above is a condensation of a long article in the New Orleans Times-Picayune news paper. I have omitted the background data and descriptions of square dancing, so familiar to square dancers. The Editor

Following is a condensation of an article from the American Square Dance magazine by caller Tom Rudeback regarding recruiting new square dancers.

A Way That Worked

We were asked to see if we could figure out a way to turn around the declining membership in our association. After talking to callers and dancers from all over we concluded we had two problems: Recruiting and Lesson format.

Most recruiting has been done by advertising using flyer and placing Ads or notices in periodicals. Occasionally someone asks a friend to come take lessons. Whatever we have been doing hasn't worked very well.

Clubs try different methods but come to the conclusion that new dancers do not flock like eagles, you have to find them one at a time. We met with clubs and talked about recruiting new dancers. We think they need to perceive themselves as dancers from the very beginning, not as students.

The plan called for the club to start about 7 months before lessons are scheduled. They start by appointing a lesson coordinator and setting up a database of prospective new dancers. Two months before the lessons start the club sends a letter to everyone in the database, introducing the club, describing the non-square dance activities and suggesting to the prospects that getting to know the club would be fun.

Also, two months before the lessons start the club sends out invitations to a "party night". The party night takes on the personality of the club and can be a chill supper or salad supper or whatever. At this time the prospects meet club member. The purpose is to "sell" the club not square dancing.

A month before the party night the recruiter who made the first contact calls to confirm the prospects attendance at the party. Two weeks before the party the club sends a follow-up invitation. Three days before the party the recruiter calls and offers a ride to the party.

At the party the prospects are seated with a club member who is selected because they are upbeat and positive about the club and square dancing. Ideally there are three prospective couples and one club member couple at each table - just the right number for a square. After eating and conversation the caller gets an experienced square up to show square dancing. Then get the new dancers up and teach them the beginning moves. In fifteen minutes they are having fun and square dancing. Sign them up for lessons before they leave.
