Paul W. Bartow, Sr., 79, of Zephyrhills, passed away from Alzheimer's Tuesday, July 10, 2007 in Zephyrhills.

He was born September 16, 1927 in Indianapolis, Indiana and came to Zephyrhills in 1990 from Lakeland, FL. Paul graduated from Lakeland High School and was retired from the U.S. Postal Service and spent five years with the Polk County Sheriff's Department. He was a veteran of the U.S. Navy, serving in the Pacific Theater during WWII. He was a little league coach in Lakeland, FL, an active member of the Lakeland Boosters Club, a member of the Good Times Band, a member of the American Legion Post 220 in Clayton, Georgia and a member of Victory Baptist Church. He also was past President of Buttons & Bows square dance club of Lakeland.

He is survived by his wife, Sheila Barlow of Zephyrhills; two sons; a daughter, eight grandchildren; one great grandchild; two stepsons; and two stepdaughters. Graveside services were held on Friday, July 13 at Lakeview Cemetery in Lakeland, FL [where he was laid to rest next to his first wife, Patsy]. Your Florida Delegates have been doing our job! Reports from the Prescription Card Program Chairman showed that Florida was in the top 5 states in prescriptions filled. Paul & I took on the USDA Online Shopping Mall and are very proud that Florida Federation organization showed 4 usages out of 8, from the report dates of September 1, 2006 through April 30, 2007. Total commission earned for this period was \$15.79. Jim Weber Mall Administrator brought before the delegates a discussion to allow square dance apparel vendors the opportunity to have a link on the USDA Shopping Mall, for a fee of \$25.00. No commission will be earned on the sales at the square dance apparel shops but will be a convenience for our dancers. The delegates voted to allow the vendors to participate on the Shopping Mall.
