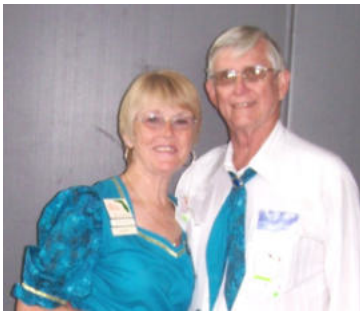

Our first West Coast Dance of the season was held in Saint Petersburg on October 20th. Our next dance will be in Estero on December 8th.

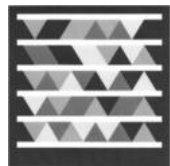
