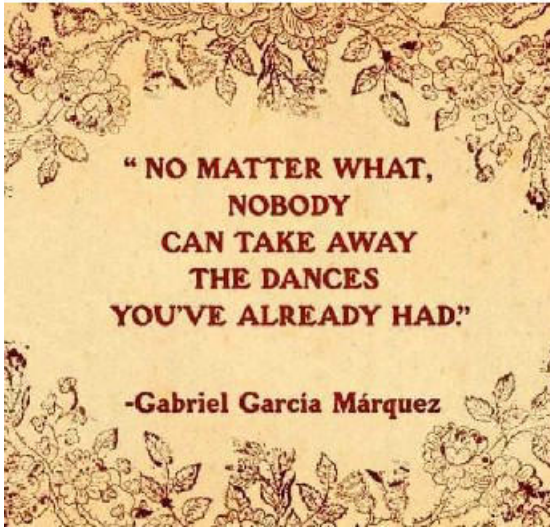

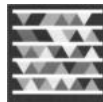

2017 West Coast Association 43rd Fall Fun Fest

Here we are, half way through 2017 already! That means the West Coast Association's 43rd Fall Fun Fest is getting closer! We hope you are making plans to join us in Bartow on November 10 – 11, 2017 at the Bartow Civic Center for the time of your life. Advance ribbons are \$18 per person for the entire weekend. The ribbons increase to \$20 per person at the door for the entire weekend. If you can't make it for the entire weekend, you can come for different portions of the weekend, but you have to purchase those ribbons at the door. If you want to just dance Friday night after 6:00 p.m. or just Saturday night after 6:00 p.m., the price is \$10 per person, and if you only want to dance all day and into the evening on Saturday, the price is \$15 per person.

There are three hotels honoring the square dance rate: Hampton Inn ([863-535-5007](tel:863-535-5007)), Holiday Inn Express([863-533-8070](tel:863-533-8070)), and Stay Inn & Suites ([863-533-0711](tel:863-533-0711)). Be sure to ask for that square dance rate! All three hotels are in the same general area of north Bartow, near food and shopping and a short distance from the convention center.

In addition to all the dancing – dances on Friday night and Saturday night and workshops during the day on Saturday, there are so many other things to do in the area. You'll want to come a few days earlier or stay over a few more days to see it all! We will be entertained at the Fall Fun Fest by Don Moger, a caller new to our area, Bob Stern from Central Florida, and Jimmy and Carol Griffin from St. Pete, Florida. The main hall will be alternating Mainstream and Plus with Rounds, and there will be a separate room for Advance Dancing with numbers. Rounds will be Phase II – IV. On Saturday, we will have a street dance in downtown Bartow. This has become a tradition and everyone looks forward to it!

We look forward to welcoming you to the city of Bartow, which is the county seat of Polk County. Bartow has a population of

less than 20,000 people but it's packed full of things to do while you are here. Just in Bartow alone, there are bed and breakfast inns, antique shops, lots of restaurants, and shopping. During the weekend of our Festival, the downtown Bartow streets will be blocked to traffic as they have their annual craft and antique fair. There is also

- **Main Street Bartow** - The Main Street Bartow community is an eclectic collection of restaurants with local and international tastes, boutiques, cafe's, antiques, salons, gift and home decor stores intermingled with professional services synonymous with a county seat. Main Street Bartow is also the home of Polk County's History Center, housed in the Historic Polk County Courthouse, which was built in 1908. The Museum collection includes natural and cultural objects related to Polk County and the greater central Florida area that represent the area's history from pre-European times through the present.
- **L. B. Brown House** - The oldest black residence in Bartow, this Victorian style building was built in the late 1800s by Lawrence Bernard Brown, a self-taught master carpenter and former slave.
- **Homeland Heritage Park** (south Bartow) - Homeland Heritage Park represents an early Florida historical community dating back to the mid 1800's. The historical buildings featured within the park are: Homeland schoolhouse and church, the Raulerson house, English Log Cabin, and Pole Barn
- **Peace River Paddling Trail** - The Peace River, true to its name, is a serene, slow-moving river with few signs of civilization. Due to its scenic nature, the Peace River is a designated Florida paddling trail.

We lost **Ed Chartier** on Friday, August 11th. He was 95 years young. His service will be Saturday, August 26th at 11:00 a.m.

Ed and Grace were secretaries of Buttons & Bows of Lakeland several times. They had to stop dancing due to health issues for both of them.

Also, a member of Buttons & Bows of Lakeland, **Sherwood Smith**, 92.5 years old the Prior family moved to Michigan, where Larry continued his career as a lithographer and became interested in Square Dancing. Summer is heating up in the Enchanted Forest, and the gnomes have been doing their best to calm down the dragons so they won't make as much heat. The saplings planted for the Convention's wood floor are growing well, and they have gotten their bark as well as their bite!

We would like to tell you about a new feature that your Ways and Means wizards will be bringing around soon. Wish trees are a Japanese tradition where people write their wishes on paper or wood and hang them from trees or wire forms resembling trees. I can't tell you how often the wishes come true, but I can say for sure that when you buy a wish, it will help our dreams of a great Convention come true by helping to pay for the flooring. We will have colorful paper and other materials to choose from, and you can decorate them any way you fancy. Make a wish, say Hi to that special someone, or share whatever philosophy happens to move you at the moment. Put anything you want (that would not be bleeped on broadcast TV) on the card, and we will display it for the duration of the Convention. We have mentioned the Blast Class before, and we would like to remind you of the opportunity that is available for new dancers and dancers who will be taking classes in February. Wizards Bob [Ormsbee] and Keith [Stevens] are preparing a great weekend of fun and learning for folks who are new to square dancing. The class is intended for people who are completely new to square dance, and for people who are already taking lessons.

The goal will be to teach about half of the mainstream program, but the focus will be on a fun weekend and a chance for learners to get some good floor time.

In the past, there was really nothing for people to do at a Convention until they had completed Mainstream classes. This class will give your friends a chance to experience the fun of dance as well as the fellowship and excitement of a whole convention of dancers. Please let your non-dancer friends know about this opportunity, and please ask your caller to announce it when your fall or winter square dance classes begin. Also, at the Convention, please stop by the class from time to time to be angels. Ribbons for Blast Class students will be \$35 no matter when they register.

Lastly, I have a few words about the dress code. Some folks have actually asked me what “clothing required” means. Many of us love getting all gussied up in our Square-Dance Finest. Nothing beats the sight of folks in their fancy outfits, skirts whipping and bolos flying. And some folks are a little put off by it. Wizard Linda and I frequently go out in square dance outfits, and never, not once, ever, has anybody told us “I just have to learn to square dance so I can dress up like that too!” So, what kind of clothing is required, you might ask. Go ahead, I’m listening.

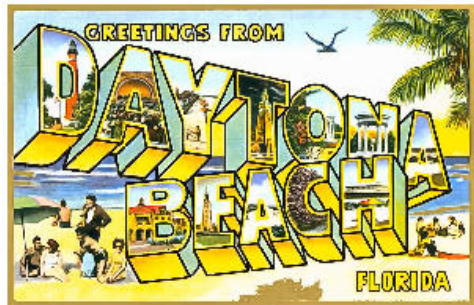

As many square dancers are aware, Henry Ford was a great proponent of square dance, requiring his many employees to participate. In 1924, he wished to employ Benjamin Lovett as caller and dance teacher in Dearborn, Michigan, but Mr. Lovett was under contract with the Wayside Inn. After failing to negotiate the release of Mr. Lovett’s contract, Mr. Ford purchased the Wayside Inn, satisfied Mr. Lovett’s contract, and hired him to teach in Dearborn. Lovett’s contract was for 2 months, but he stayed in Dearborn for 26 years. What is little known is that back then, Clarence the Misguided Magician, at the time known simply as Wizard Clarence, was also involved in dancing. Clarence could see how happy people were when dancing, and he wished that he could find a way to record the joy of dance, and preserve the history of Square Dance for future generations. Clarence made a pair of happy dancing statuettes from clay, and he enchanted them to remember the happiness of the dances that they attended. He made them look just like his friends Kenneth and Barbara Dollander, and the other wizards thought that Clarence had actually turned his friends into statuettes. This got Clarence demoted to Magician, and he has been known as Clarence the Misguided Magician ever since.
