LAZY SUMMER SPONGE CAKE

1 C	Milk	$\frac{1}{4}$ C	Butter or Oleo
4	Eggs	1 $\frac{3}{4}$ C	Sugar
1 t	Vanilla	1 $\frac{3}{4}$ C	All Purpose Flour
1 T	Baking Powder	$\frac{1}{2}$ t	Salt

Heat milk to scalding, add butter and set aside. In large mixer bowl combine eggs, sugar and vanilla. Beat $1\frac{1}{2}$ minutes at high speed until thick and lemon color. Add dry ingredients, beat for 1 minute, at low speed. Pour batter into 13 x 9" greased pan. Bake at 350 degrees for 30 to 35 minutes, or until cake springs back when lightly touched in center. Cool slightly and spread with topping.

TOPPING:

$\frac{1}{2}$ C	Cream or Evaporated Milk
$\frac{2}{3}$ C	Firming Packed Brown Sugar
1 C	Flaked Coconut
$\frac{1}{2}$ C	Chopped Nuts

In a small sauce pan, combine cream and brown sugar and bring to boil and cook over medium heat for 3 minutes. Stir in cocoanuts and nuts. Spread over cake.
