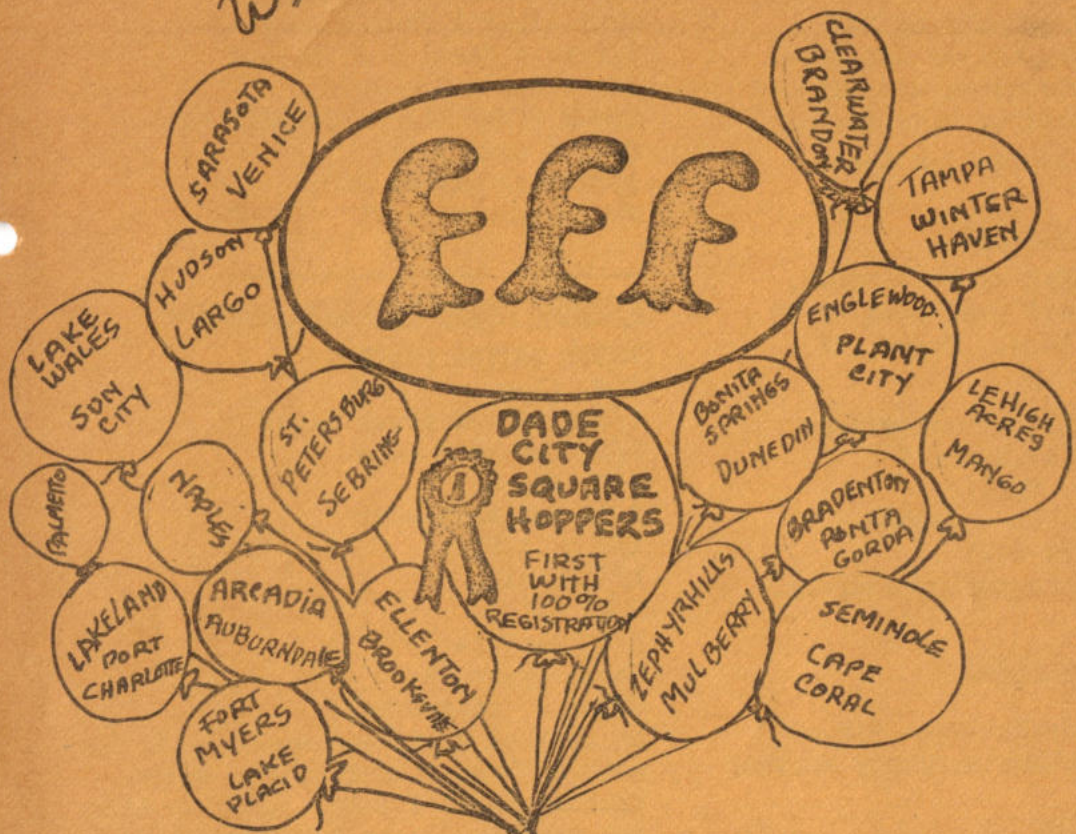

## KITCHEN KOLUM BY GINNY WALTHER

### FUDGE BATTER PUDDING

1 C. flour  
1/2 C packed brown sugar  
1/2 C chopped nuts  
3 T. cocoa  
2 t. baking powder  
1/2 t. salt  
1/2 C. milk  
2 T. oil  
1 t. vanilla  
cocoa syrup \*\*  
Cream or half & half  
In greased 2 qt. casserole, stir to-  
gether flour, sugar, nuts, cocoa,  
baking powder & salt. Combine milk,  
and vanilla - stir into dry mixture  
until well blended. Pour Cocoa  
syrup on top. Wipe edges of cassero-  
le and bake in preheated 350° oven  
40 min. or until pick inserted in  
center comes out clean. Serve warm  
in bowls, spooning a portion of cake  
with cocoa syrup. Pass the cream.  
COCOA SYRUP: Combine 1/2 C. packed  
brown sugar & 1/4 C. cocoa. Stir in  
1 2/3 C. hot water & 1 t. vanilla  
until smooth & well blended.

Note: I use vanilla ice-cream on  
mine in place of half & half.

FIRST PLEASE CHECK ALL AREA DANCES THE 1st WEEKEND OF SEPT. THIS IS THE KNOTHEAD KONVENTION AND ALMOST ALL CLUBS CANCEL THEIR DANCES IN DEFERENCE TO THIS FUNCTION.

With the material that is to be put in this magazine, was a slip of paper that said only "Square Dance Villa (take out of magazine)!" I don't know whether that means all listings for that location, or if that was intended for a specific caller. It would be wise, I think, to check this out before driving there to attend a dance..

The week of September 20th through the 26th has been proclaimed National Square Dance Week. This means promotion of square dancing to make the general public more aware of what we are doing, etc.; recognition of this family-oriented recreation..Is your club doing something in this line? If not, try to work up something for next year!

The NorthEast Square and Round Dancing Association each year holds a weekend festival, bringing in two of the nations' top callers, along with the nations' best round dance leaders. This is always an outstanding affair held at the Jacksonville Aud. Those who've attended each year will verify the caliber of this affair. This year they will have Vaughn Parrish from Aurora, Colorado and Jon Jones from Texas calling and the well-known Easterdays on rounds. Sunday afternoon Vaughn & Jean Parrish will give a free styling clinic for those who wish to stay. This weekend will be the 12th and 13th of November, 1976.

THE 24th FLORIDA STATE SQUARE & ROUND DANCERS CONVENTION will be held May 27, 28th & 29th, 1977 at the New Lakeland Civic Center. The callers will be Lee Kopman of New York & Chris Vear, who hails from Germany, but now is residing in the US. To cap this, they have selected Charlie & Marge Carter from Ohio to lead the rounds. Many flyers are out on this festival and if you hurry, you can get the hotel of your choice (the rates are in the flyers). Make life easier for the registration chairman by registering early.

A square of dancers from the Left Allemanders will be appearing on the Jane Johnston TV show on channel 44 Mon, Sept. 20 at 12:30. The purpose of this exhibition is to focus attention on National Square Dance Week as well as to promote Square Dancing in our area by emphasizing the Fall Classes.

Repeated requests for a special workshop to help the newer round dancer with the somewhat difficult transition from easy basics into intermedite bascs has brought about this continuing workshop on a once a month basis. Open to all dancers who feel the need for special instruction on basics such as HOVER, WING, WHISK, SPIN, TURN ETC. These terms are just sets of steps to be mastered in the same manner (only easier, we hope) as you brought the terms, BOX, VINE, PIVOT, TWO STEP, under your control. ie., Sessions of practics and informative workshops.
