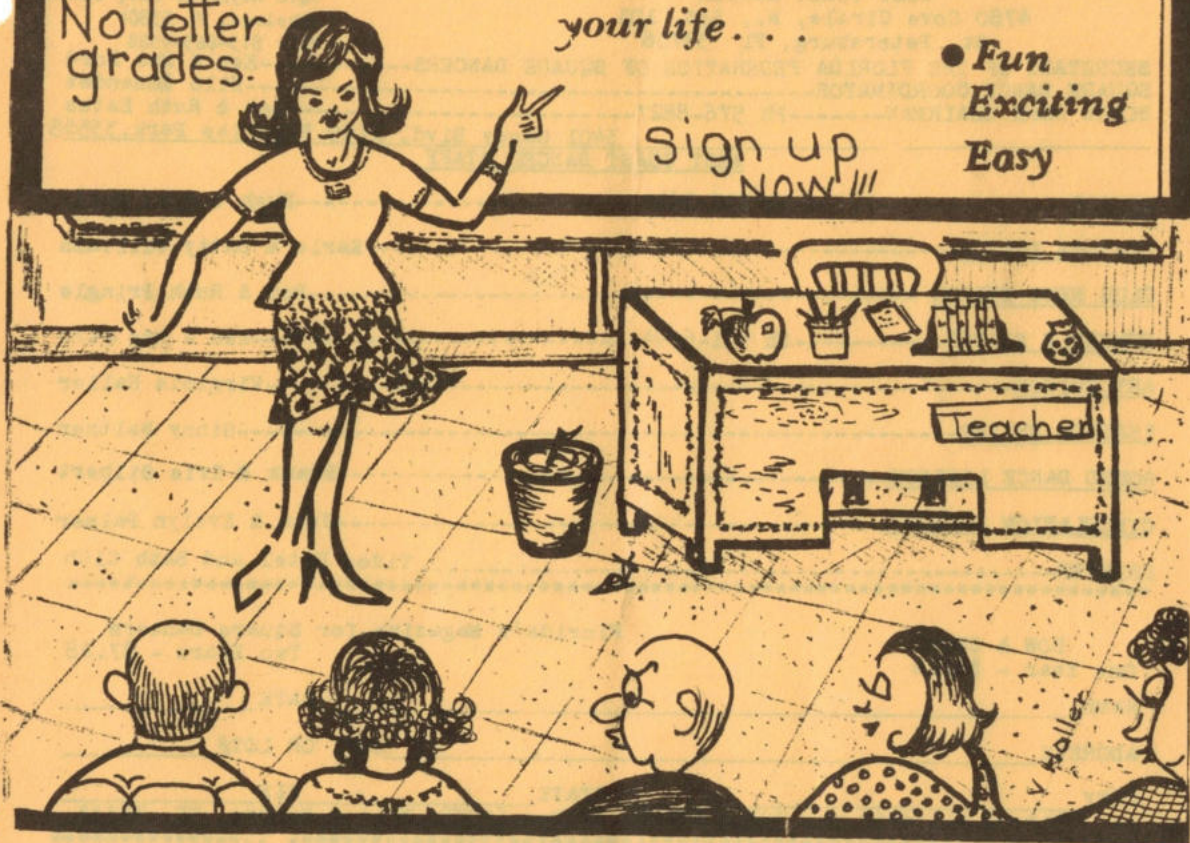

Dear Editors: Over the years my husband and I have been taking a survey of dancers from Mainstream (including graduates) through advanced. Since so many dancers quit after a year or two there must be a reason. The following letter addressed to the "callers" shows what we found.

Dear Callers: August, 1980
First let me say, the West Coast has the best Square Dance Callers to be found anywhere. However, many dancers quit for the following reasons:

Why dancers quit

1. You invite graduates to your dances then call above their level and try to push them to higher levels too fast. SO THEY QUIT.
2. Several callers love to workshop a dance. You also workshop figures no one will ever hear again. A waste of time. They want to dance. SO THEY QUIT.
3. Some callers have dancers running through dances. A majority of Florida dancers are middle aged or older. Too Strenuous. SO THEY QUIT.
4. The majority of dancers want callers to call mainstream, plus 1 & 2 as advertised and do not care for all position dancing. SO THEY QUIT.
5. A minority like a challenge. So, keep all position dancing and figures you want to try out at an advanced level. This minority love to workshop anything new or years old but keep it out of the general stream of dances.
6. Use what is in Mainstream plus 1 & 2 level in your patter calls and singing calls. THERE IS PLENTY, IF YOU USE ALL OF IT.
7. Dancers come for relaxation, enjoyment and fun. How about it, fellows? You are a great group guys. LET'S KEEP THEM DANCING.
