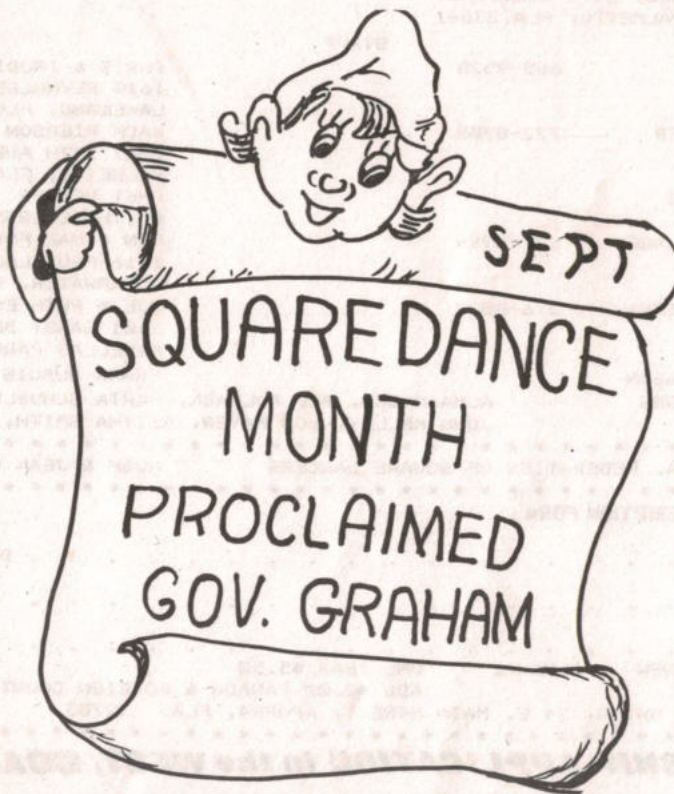

State of Florida
Executive Department
Tallahassee

WHEREAS, square dancing is one of the most ancient recreational heritages of the American people; and

WHEREAS, this healthy folk art has enjoyed a sustained and widespread popularity through the centuries, and said interest is still intense today; and

WHEREAS, square dancing assuaged the dangers and hardships of the frontier; and

WHEREAS, folk and square dances are an integral, important and expressive part of American art and culture; and

WHEREAS, the outgoing social exercise of this wholesome physical and old-time cultural activity offers a valuable antidote for the tensions and pressures created by the conflicts and ultra sophistication of modern American life; and

WHEREAS, the various square dance associations throughout the United States and Canada, including the Florida Federation of Square Dancers and the Florida Callers Association, will celebrate the month of September as National Square Dance Month;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Bob Graham, by virtue of the authority vested in me as Governor of the State of Florida, do hereby proclaim the month of September 1984, as

SQUARE DANCE MONTH


in Florida, in serious recognition of the essential importance of this universal art form of the American people.
