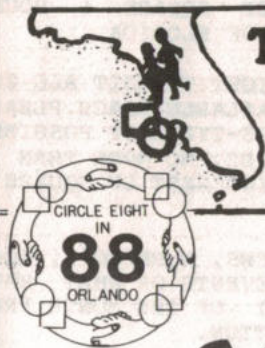

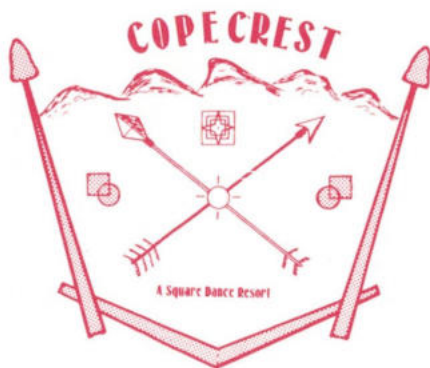

Dance Convention


