#### Words from the Editor

We had another successful West Coast Membership Dance in Bartow this afternoon but the attendance was down a little from previous years. I hope that means that the people that were missing were over at Strawberry Square supporting the Student Dance with Jimmy Lee! It was the "caller's nightmare" with all the red and white; a few of us tried to help out with a different color here and there (LOL). There was a Suncoast Callers and Cuers meeting just before the dance, so there were several who stayed and enjoyed an afternoon of visiting or dancing with their partners. Thank you to Hampton Promenaders of Auburndale for providing the delicious refreshments.

Thank you to the callers who made sure the unattached solos got a chance to dance; we appreciated it very much.

I attended a part of the Callers & Cuers meeting and one of the discussions was about dancers dancing above their level and dances being called above the level of the floor. There was a sharing of ideas on how to determine the level of the floor and there was discussion about dancers encouraging mainstream dancers to join plus tips. Most of our clubs alternate tips (mainstream/plus). If a dancer can only dance to the mainstream level, they should not be encouraged to join a plus tip. They only become frustrated if they are be pulled and spun around through most of the tip. Several of the clubs have a sign on the callers table to announce which level is being called. If your club doesn't utilize a sign, I highly recommend that you do. This helps when the caller forgets to announce the level of the next tip, and it helps people like me who don't pay attention to what the level is; I just get up and dance all of them! If you dance the Plus level, you are a mainstream dancer too so get up and help the mainstream dancers. A new dancer who has only learned the basic movements is not ready for a mainstream tip so encouraging them to come to a mainstream dance and dancing that level is not recommended. They will only become frustrated and may decide not to continue with classes. We can't afford to discourage new dancers in any way!

Next weekend will be a busy weekend for square dancers - a multi-level weekend with Tim Crawford at Strawberry Square in Plant City, Knothead Konvention in Melbourne and the Blue-Grey Dance in Lake City plus all the regularly scheduled club dances. So you shouldn't have any problem finding somewhere to dance!

Thank you to those of you who promote this newsletter and to Tom Perry for posting it on the Florida Dance Web. This started out as a small club newsletter, then grew into a Polk County newsletter and look at it now! The distribution list is up to 281 and several of those people forward it on to their club members. This can be a good communication tool for everyone, but it is only as good as the information I receive from all of you; please keep sending the information so that I have current and accurate information to pass on to the dancers. Club Presidents, please help me out by printing two or three copies of each issue to put on your flyer table for those that might be visiting or your members who do not have email. I try to bring copies when I visit a club but I can't get to every one.

In addition to dancing, you will be able to walk through the fair and visit the vendors and see the different shows. Remember how much fun it was go to the fair as a child?
