
## **Words from the Editor**



Chuck was born Dec. 7, 1927, in Linesville, Penn. He grew up on a dairy farm. After graduating from high school, he enlisted in the U.S. Navy and served two years. When he returned to Linesville, he worked for the A&P Tea Company for 15 years, as meat cutter, produce manager and store manager. He went on to build steel buildings and operate a fast food business. Chuck and his son, Lee, also built three homes.

Chuck and Joan began square dancing in 1959 and Chuck soon taught himself to call. He traveled around Pennsylvania and Ohio calling dances for many years.

After several winter vacations to St. Petersburg to visit relatives, Chuck and Joan finally decided to move to Florida in 1979. They lived in St. Petersburg for nine years while they managed an apartment building. Chuck and Lee worked together doing remodeling and repairs.

In 1988, after their daughter, Kay was married in St. Petersburg, Chuck and Joan bought a small mobile park in Chiefland and moved to the country. They took up square dancing again, and Chuck taught square dance classes at a local church. The Young at Heart Square Dancers continue to dance at the Senior Center.

Chuck was a man of simple pleasures. He loved spending time with his family, camping in his motor home, and reading a good book. He was a kind and gentle man, rarely speaking a harsh word and always there to lend a hand if a friend needed help. His death leaves a void in the hearts of his family and close friends.

Survivors include his wife Joan Donaldson; his son Lee Donaldson; his daughter, Kay Keen; his grandchildren, Lauren, Alex and Jenny Keen; his sisters, Mildred Christian, Elaine Thomas, and Esther Ray; six nieces and nephews; 11 grand nieces and nephews; and nine great-grand nieces and nephews.

The family will receive friends from 12-3 p..m. on March 16 at Hiers-Baxley Funeral Services, 1301 N. Young Blvd. Chiefland.
