Another update was received on the 16th: The pacemaker was put in; that is working fine however, her lungs are progressively failing. She is having to wear a mask to help her breath and is now on 70% oxygen. She is resting comfortably The outlook is not good so prayers are needed. Carol looked better today as she slept real good with that sleep apnia machine on. Her stats were much better today. Our primary care doctor came in and looked at everything and as he left he said "miracle". Apparently the heart problem cause the current lung problem as some mucus could not be absorbed and built up in the lungs. She sat up and played cards with Carlene (our daughter from TX. and maintained better than 90% oxygen. last night she had on a machine for sleep apnia which forced more air into her lungs than normal, along with other treatments. No temperature. speaking much better. Oxygen use still high at 70%. We will see if the stats hold up tomorrow. Keep praying.... - (IT'S WORKING)
