Words from the Editor

If your club dances or you have square or round dance classes on a Thursday night, Friday night, during the day Saturday, Saturday night, during the day Sunday or Sunday night, I hope you have made plans to be closed in support of the Florida Sate Convention on May 22nd, 23rd, 24th or 25th. The Florida State Convention is <u>YOUR</u> convention - dancers, callers and cuers. There are 34 callers and 12 cuers scheduled for your dancing pleasure. There will be 20 hours of dancing in each of the halls.

If your clubs and or classes will be closed, please let me know so it can be advertised in the DANCERgram. I would hate for someone to show up for a dance and there not be anyone there to greet them!

Along those same lines, the dance information in the DANCERgram is only as good as the information provided to me. Unfortunately, I can't make it to every dance. I would love to but I can't be everywhere. I have to depend on all of you to keep me informed on what your clubs are doing. Dancers want to know specifics i.e. themes, callers' and

cuer's names. They don't want to just see 'Guest Callers/Cuers'. And if there is a change in the caller or cuer, they want to know that too. And especially if a dance is canceled or moved; we need to get that kind of information out to the dancers as quickly as possible. I would be happy to send out an addendum during the week if it's needed.

I had an email from Sun City Center this weekend to let me know that they had set a record for their club on the number of people they took on a raid to the BATS - 31 people; 13 of them were newer members and some of them were on their first raid. CONGRATULATIONS! It's great to get new members involved in raids.

Health and Sympathy Updates

Fred Cornett (past Federation President) - message from his wife, Shirley:

"Fred had a PET scan on Thursday. Dr. Williamson said that 98% of his cancer is gone! Thanks to all of you for your prayers, love, and concern. We know that prayers are being answered. We expect that Fred will have two more chemo treatments -- one this month and one in June. After that, Dr. Patton will tell us what the next step (if any) will be.

The fourth chemo that Fred had almost three weeks ago has really made him feel "yucky." Headaches, nausea, and dizzy spells. Nothing that he can't handle, but everything he would rather <u>not have</u> to handle. Dr. Williamson said yesterday that his symptoms are normal. She said that normally the first three treatments are a build up to the fourth. Apparently, on the fourth treatment the docs hit the cancer with a stronger dose of medication than they do on the first three. In addition, there is always some residual chemo left in the system from prior treatments. The Christians Love & Care at CLC recently gave Fred a beautiful prayer shawl. It is a brown, basket weave, knitted one. We are <u>both</u> enjoying the shawl. It is such a comfort to physically wrap ourselves in so many prayers.

Again, thanks for all your prayers. We know that God answers prayer and feel that His answer to ours at this point is "Okay, I can do that for you."

I received another update on Fred this morning just as I was ready to send out this DANCERgram!

Good news! Prayers continue to be answered! Fred had a PET scan on Thursday and 98% of the lymphoma is gone. He still has a hot spot on his tonsil and several below the waist, but we are confident that the treatment he will receive this month and next month will take care of what is left.

Dr. Williamson (at the Angel Williamson Imaging Center) said that before 2001 cancer was almost an automatic death sentence among the older population without the means to pay for scans on their own. In 2001 Medicare started paying for the PET/CT scans. These scans give a much better picture of how the treatment is working as opposed to blood tests and she said the survival rate has just continued to go up. Of course, she sees cancer patients all day long so has a different outlook than most of us, but she now equates cancer with other chronic

illnesses such as diabetes, high blood pressure, heart disease, etc. i.e. cancer is treatable. It may not be curable, but it is treatable. She wants to do another scan on Fred 6 - 8 months after his last treatment to be sure there are no signs of the return of the cancer.

The fourth chemo treatment that Fred received on April 7 is really a rough one. He has had bouts of nausea, headaches, dizzy spells, etc. Dr. Williamson told us that this is typical of the fourth treatment. She said that the fourth treatment is stronger than the first three and of course, there is some residual buildup of chemo from the first treatments. Right now Fred is not having a great time, but we are so grateful that the treatment is working and know that there is light at the end of the tunnel.

Paul Place - I have not had any Care Page updates on Paul since the last update I sent you, but there were some dancers from Whirl & Twirl (Paul's club in Orlando) at Strawberry Square

Saturday night so I talked to them to see if I could find out anything new. One of the gentlemen told me he talked to Paul a couple of days ago and that Paul and Linda have moved to Auburn and that their daughter, Christy, and her family have also moved there. Paul has not had any chemo treatments and is checking out some alternative treatments. I also found out that Paul is still booked for the Strawberry Square New Year's Eve party and will remain booked as the caller until they hear otherwise from Linda Place. A caller is on stand-by just in case.

(EDITOR'S NOTE: I so agree with President Randy Poole's message in the *Bow & Swing* this month, that I had to include it in this issue. Of course, Carole could have written the message!)

Imagine for a minute you have invited all of your friends to a party at your house. The party is to last two hours. After one hour they start to leave one by one, two by two. By the end of the party there are only a few friends remaining. What would you think? How would you feel?

Many years ago when we started square dancing, the dance lasted for three hours. Yes, we were younger then, but there were retired dancers in our club. About nine o'clock the tables would be set up and we had a pot luck dinner. After about thirty minutes the dance started back up. And everyone stayed until the dance ended. After the dance we headed home or to someone's house for some refreshments and joke telling. The house would be bulging with people.

Fast forward 30 years and the dance lasts for only two hours and more than half the dancers start leaving after one hour! This is really insulting to the caller. He has prepared his agenda for the evening and he must think he failed to make it interesting or entertaining enough. What is so important that we cannot stay until the end of the party? People leave sporting events and church early to beat the crowd (that is NOT a problem with most

square dances!). The dancer is getting a bad reputation for being impolite and rude to the caller. Let's change that image and stay until the end of the dance.

P.S. The last tip is usually the best of the evening.

Sorry...but the Editor has to add her two cents worth! When I started dancing about 25 years ago, the first club I joined danced until 10:30 p.m. Even though our club had two full six or eight foot long tables of finger foods for refreshments, we still went out to eat after the dance! At every dance during the last tip, every time promenade was called, everyone changed squares.

And back on my "soap box" about why we make a circle at the end of the night instead of a semi-circle. If we make a circle, we exclude the caller and cuer when we say the final thank you. Many times that is the only thank you they get as many of the dancers leave without going up front and thanking the caller and cuer. When I learned to square dance, we were taught in class that you applaud the caller before you thank everyone in your circle. So many times lately, I see people just walk away from the square and don't even thank each other, let alone applaud the caller. Women this includes you; you should be thanking everyone in the square too it's not just up to the men to do the thank yous. And what about applauding the cuer after each round?
