Health Updates

Bud Taylor – past president of the Northwest Assn. and chairman of the 2010 Florida State Convention, had arthroscopic knee surgery earlier this week. He is making a good recovery at home.

Joe Vacarri - has been very involved in the Florida Federation and in the USDA for many years. This is a note from Joy about Joe's condition.

Hi everyone,

Joe had his last radiation treatment a week ago Tuesday.

They repeated the PET/CT scan this past Monday and found no hot spots. The right lung has re expanded and the bronchial tube appeared open on the scan. They decided that the little spots in the base of his lungs were actually scar tissue from the pneumonia rather than metastasis from the kidney as originally thought. They are slowly becoming smaller.

They did a repeat bronchoscopy (take a look) yesterday and found a small piece of the tumor so they did the third seed (brachytherapy) treatment just in case even though the Doctor knew there were no cancerous cells in it (from the scan).

Diagnosis: Joe is remission for the time being. Dr. Amos said sometimes his patients remain cancer free and sometimes it does return. We will continue to pray for the former. We feel fortunate to have found a Doctor who does not subscribe to hopelessness.

His kidney tumor has not grown in the past three months so we decided to hold off on the biopsy until they do another PET/CT scan in three months. If it grows we will then get a biopsy and depending on the results will treat it probably with a relatively new medication (technically not chemotherapy but some tend to call it that).

Prayer works and we want to thank everyone who has been praying for us. We are most grateful. It's a far cry from the original hopeless diagnosis of Stage IV incurable cancer that we received back in early May.

Joe says he feels almost normal again. He is still coughing but not nearly as bad as before.

West Coast Association

I have been receiving questions this past week regarding taking a West Coast office. If one person has these questions, then others may have them too so I want to share them with all of you.

- If you become a WC officer, are you required to join the Federation and attend those meetings? You aren't required to join the Federation and attend the meetings, but as president you would be expected to attend to present the West Coast report. The other officers would be asked to serve as delegates to the meeting; however, you are asked before being named as a delegate.
- How many Federation meetings are there and where are they held? There are a total of three; two are held in a location at the discretion of the current president and one is held the same weekend as the Florida State Convention. For 2008/2009, the meetings are held as follows:
 - a. Sunday, November 22, 2008 in Jacksonville the same weekend as the Northeast Association Fall Festival. Since this is quite a drive for some of us to just drive up for a Sunday morning meeting, we also attend the weekend festival. You could also do this or just attend the Festival Saturday night and stay over for the Sunday morning meeting. The location of this meeting changes each year; last year it was in Bartow the same weekend as our Fall Fun Fest.
 - Last weekend in February February 28 March 1, 2008 Working Weekend –
 Plant City. This Weekend starts at 9:00 a.m. on Saturday with a business

meeting. The business meeting adjourns around 12:00 noon for breakout sessions on various subjects that you sign up for. These sessions are usually finished in an hour or two. Sometimes they include lunch. The meeting starts again on Sunday morning at 9:00 a.m. to report back from the breakout sessions, and we are usually finished by noon. The Working Weekend will always be the last weekend in February but the location will change at the discretion of the current president. At the last Federation meeting, it was decided to start having a dance as part of the Working Weekend to benefit the 2010 Florida State Convention. The dance will be held at Stardust Center in 2009.

c. Sunday of the Weekend of State Convention. This meeting is always held the Sunday of the weekend the Florida State Convention is held and starts at 9:00 a.m. We are usually finished by noon.

You are welcome to come just for the meetings, but since many of us also attend all the conventions and festivals, we go for the entire weekend. Scheduling the meetings the same weekend as a festival reduces the amount of travelling we have to do.

We didn't recruit any new dancers that day, but we did bring a lot of happiness to many that day. Thank you, Jack and Barbara, for a wonderful idea. And thank you SusanElaine for donating your time. What a great way to start the convention."

Do You Want to Dance?

"Do you want to dance?" That was the title of a column on the front page of the *Florida Today* newspaper, Sunday July 6, 2008. I have copied the column as follows:

Sixth-graders could be required to take dance and gymnastics and high school students may have the option of enrolling in a gun safety class or going water skiing to fulfill a physical education requirement. These are some of the proposed changes to Florida's physical education standards that the public is being asked to comment on. If adopted by the State Board of Education at its October meeting, the requirements would take effect in the 2009-10 school year. "We want PE to be more than throwing a ball," said Todd Clark, who is helping lead the process for the Board of Education. "The state has been looking carefully at trying to be smart about having students be active and lifelong athletes." Last year, Gov. Charlie Crist, an advocate for physical fitness, helped ensure the passage of a law that required elementary students to have 150 minutes of physical activity each week. That was more than four times the amount the average Brevard County elementary student received the previous year. This year, that law was tightened to require 30 minutes of continuous physical exercise every day for elementary students, and the next push has focused on older students. It's all part of an effort to tackle childhood obesity and promote a healthy, active lifestyle. "If you are going to attract students to take PE at the high school level, you need to try and offer a menu where the districts can provide those courses as an elective course, "Clark said. About 30 educators from around the state were selected to begin research in November 2007. They took ideas from states known for having exemplary physical education programs and passed them on to another group of educators – from elementary teachers to college professors – who wrote the recommendations. Clark recognizes that some districts may have problems getting equipment, such as canoes, golf clubs or mats, and finding proper locations to carry out the proposed activities, which include archery and horseshoes. For example, only 10 of Brevard's 85 schools

have swimming pools. Denise Dabrowski-Buchanan, who has been a PE teacher in Brevard for 19 years and currently teaches at Melbourne High, called the recommendations "great ideas, but not feasible". Joe Schmo PE teacher is not certified to teach all that stuff," Dabrowski-Buchanan said. "And the cost of equipment and expertise, with all the cutbacks, I just can't even imagine. How logical is it with all the budget cuts?" Valerie Harville, the district coordinator for Brevard Public Schools, was part of the research committee. She said educators tried to be creative in coming up with ways to attract students. "We wanted to make sure that we were giving students as many opportunities as possible to be active", Harville said. "We dug pretty deep", Lill Toler, whose daughter is going into fifth grade at Imperial Elementary in Titusville, thinks the committee dug too deep. She's concerned that physical education teachers are not qualified to teach some of the recommendations like gymnastics, Pilates or swing dance. She's also worried about how classes such as dance would affect students' selfimage. "You'll have the girls who will be out there versus the boys who might feel goofy and self-conscious", Toler said. "I like the regular sports where you run and learn techniques." Parent Lisa Smoak has a different take on the new activities. She said students, including her son who starts fifth grade at Longleaf Elementary in Melbourne, may be uncomfortable at first but "unless you show them and expose them to it, they won't know about it". She said her son's PE teacher devoted time to teaching disco dancing and it was a huge success. She's also confident the teachers will be smart when teaching the lessons. "In gymnastics, I don't think they will have them on the uneven bars, and I'm sure they won't have them doing back handsprings and that sort of thing," Smoak said. "It will just be to get them moving". This is the kind of debate and feedback the Department of Education is hoping for. Clark said the draft compiled by the educators is just that, a draft. Once the feedback deadline has passed, all comments will be reviewed and the committee will decide what items need to be clarified, expanded or deleted. "I hope the parents and teachers are going online to provide feedback," Clark said. "Are they (the recommendations) too restrictive? Should they add more items? We could really use input from parents." Contact Spitzer at 242-3722 or mspitzer@floridatoday.com to voice an opinion. The period for public comment on proposed changes to physical education standards runs until July 20.

I think this is a good opportunity for us to be heard. Maybe the FCA could hold a seminar to teach PE teachers how to teach square dance or offer our services to the State Board of Education in some way.

I contacted Valerie Harville last year regarding teaching square dance in the schools. At that time she said Brevard was developing a dance program, but it wasn't ready yet. I will be contacting her again.
