Special invitations have been sent to all of the past presidents (that we have addresses for) inviting them to join us for this special occasion.

Many people ask why we have a separate association, why we always request a Singles Section at conventions and festivals, why we have singles clubs and why we have our own convention.

Thirty years ago when this association was created, singles weren't allowed to join clubs, and in many cases weren't even allowed to dance at some clubs. So in order to be able to dance, they had to create their own opportunities. Believe it or not in this day and age, there are still some clubs and classes who do not allow singles to join or even participate without a partner. This is true even in Florida. Some clubs even have this written into their By-Laws. And there are those who even though they say they accept singles, don't make the singles feel welcome.

Since square dancing is enjoyed by predominately more senior citizens, and statistically women live longer than men, we have a growing number of single women in square dancing. So I have a feeling this association will be around for many years to come.

FASSRD is a non-profit organization established to promote and stimulate fellowship and interest in square and round

dancing among unmarried adults of all ages throughout Florida.

Membership is for any single square dancer who is 18 years or older and has graduated from a square or round dance class. The annual membership fee is \$6.

Benefits of membership are: meet other singles; quarterly newsletter containing information on singles activities in Florida and SSDUSA⁴; annual Single-Rama in October; USDA Square Dance insurance; and square dance news via email.

Promoting Square Dancing on the West Coast of Florida

How can you help promote square dancing on the west coast of Florida?

There are many things you can do that won't take much of your time or cost you any money.

There is now a West Coast brochure that provides information on not only the West Coast Association, but contact information for each of the County Reps, the Suncoast Callers & Cuers Association, each of the Square Dance Camping Groups, and the Florida Singles. Always carry a few of these when you go out to eat before or after a

dance so that when people see you in “costume” and ask about the dancing be sure to give them one. Don’t wait for them to ask about where to dance; start telling them about how much fun it is and the health, social and mental benefits of dancing. My name and contact information, as well as the Slocums’, are at the end of the brochure if someone should ask for information on an area you are not familiar with. Just have them get in touch with us and we’ll put them in touch with the right people.

In Polk County carry a few of the class brochures to hand out when asked about where to learn to dance.

If you have any kind of shirt or jacket that mentions square dancing, wear it anywhere you go i.e. shopping, dinner, movies, golfing, etc. This always generates conversation and questions.

When you visit other clubs, where your club or association badge; people will ask about your club. This will promote your club. I’ve had people visit my club because they’ve seen my badge somewhere else.

The West Coast Association has business cards which say “You have been patronized by a square dancer”. There are some that are pre-printed with various individuals’ names and contact information or there are some that are blank and you can add your own name and contact information. You can carry a few of these in your pocket,

purse or vehicle and when you are in a business you can just leave a card. These are great when you attend a festival or convention and you are using the coupons in the program booklets. This lets our supporters know that we are returning the favor of them supporting our dances.

Use this newsletter; print off a couple of copies to put on the flyer table at your dances and to have at your demos. You can print it back to back to it won’t be so many pages and just print through the page with this week’s dances so it won’t be so long. This will show the prospective dancer that there is a lot going on in our activity.

I’ve actually heard of a dancer who makes a point of stopping at the grocery store on the way to a dance in her square dance attire to pick something up, just so people will see her and ask about square dancing. How simple is that?

After all of the West Coast Membership Dances there are about 20 of us who go to a restaurant for dinner. Do you think we are noticed? You bet! And yes, we answer questions about where we have been dancing, about the “medals” on our outfits, where we are from, etc.

How much does all of this cost you? Nothing? How much of your time does it take? Almost none!

Our association covers 16 counties on the west coast of Florida, and with our

hundreds of members there should be lots of promoting going on! So let's get started!
