John Occhipinti – West Coast Photographer - was hospitalized on January 31<sup>st</sup> with a fever and severe dehydration. He was diagnosed with some kind of rare (?) infection so it took a while to decide how to treat it. On Friday, February 6<sup>th</sup> he was released from the hospital, only to return to the emergency room that night. His daughter was here for several days to care for him. Since John is rarely sick, this has been a rather frustrating experience for him. The good news is that John is feeling better, walking a little (but tires easily from being laid up for 2 1/2 weeks). # Florida Federation Working Weekend

On February 28<sup>th</sup> and March 1<sup>st</sup> the Florida Federation will be at the Stardust Center in Plant City for their annual Working Weekend. This name isn't really what it sounds like! We start with a business meeting at 9:00 a.m. on Saturday morning, break for lunch (which is on your own) and then we have breakout sessions on various topics. During these breakout sessions, each group meets separately to discuss their topic and hopefully come up with some suggestions/ideas. We usually finish up for the day around 2 or 3:00 p.m. On Sunday morning we start again at 9:00 a.m. with each of these groups reporting back to the entire group. We usually adjourn around noon.



The breakout sessions are as follows:

<u>Finance:</u> Prepare a Federation Budget for 2009. Make recommendations to the Board of Delegates concerning financial matters.

**Bob Spence (Chairman) - WC** 

<u>Dancer Preservation, Education and Publicity:</u> Discuss the problems of square dancer attrition and the lack of recruitment of new dancers. Make recommendations for possible solutions to these problems. Develop guidelines for more worthwhile projects that will aid in the enjoyment of square dancing or the enlightenment of square dancing.

Val Newsome (Chairman)-NE

**State Convention Procedures:** Review and make recommendations on changes concerning the State Convention.

Randall Poole (Chairman) - C

**Square Dancer Insurance:** To familiarize association insurance chairman with State and USDA insurance program.

Carol Poole (Chairman) - C

<u>Public Awareness and Publications:</u> Make recommendations concerning how the Federation might achieve favorable coverage or public awareness of the benefits of square dancing.

Sarah Pergrossi (Chairman) - NE

<u>Association Presidents Meeting:</u> Discus what they envision the association's responsibilities and capabilities will be in the combined State Convention.

Ouida Taylor (Chairman) - NE

<u>Historian Preservation:</u> Recommend ways to best preserve and store historical records and artifacts.

Bruce Morgan (Chairman) - C

<u>Showcase of Ideas:</u> Develop an idea for the displays to be shown by the state of Florida at the National Convention in 2009.

Jack and Barbara Hoffman (Chairman) – C

If you have an interest in any of these subjects and you have worthwhile input, please make plans to attend this weekend and participate in the breakout sessions. The West Coast Association will ensure that we have at least one representative in each of the breakout sessions but there is no limit on how many can participate in a particular session. Each year, the Working Weekend is held in a different location; since this meeting is in our "backyard", West Coast should be well represented!

# The "State" of the Florida State Convention

You have probably been hearing for quite some time about the 2010 Florida State Convention being a "truly state-wide convention", and you're probably wondering what this means. Hasn't it always been a state-wide convention?

As you know, our state is divided into five regional associations. Up until the 2009 convention, each year it has been hosted by one of these associations. Every five years we knew that West Coast Association would be hosting a convention and we had that much time to plan and raise funds to host it.

Starting with the 2010 convention, it will no longer be hosted by an association. Each year the Florida Federation president will "appoint" a general chairman for the next convention needing to be planned. This is usually three to four years out. The general chairmen for the 2010 convention are Bud and Anita Taylor who live in Jacksonville, which is part of the Northeast Association but that association is not hosting the event. In 2011, the general chairmen are two solos, Terry little and Ailene Picheco, who are both from Central but it won't be hosted by the Central Association. The general chairmen will then fill their committees with dancers from all over the state not just within their respective associations.

Each of these chairmen will then work with a representative from each of the five regional associations to raise funds for the convention. Each association needs to raise approximately \$2,000 dollars. Each association will have their own fundraising events to raise their share of the funds to put towards this event.

Even with all this fundraising, it won't be near enough money to cover all the expenses of putting on a state convention. The biggest expense of the whole weekend is the rent at the Lakeland Center. The Federation has looked at other locations along the I-4 corridor that would be cheaper but either the other locations had carpeted floors, which meant we would have to rent flooring, or the rent was even higher or both.

Why do we have to keep the location along the I-4 corridor you ask? We (the Federation which are your representatives) feel that keeping the location along the I-4 corridor is a central location to the <u>majority</u> of the state. And you probably ask why it has to be in the same location each year. When you are dealing with a large facility like the Lakeland Center, Orlando Convention Center, etc. you have to "get in line" on their waiting list to book a facility for a whole weekend. If we loose our "place" on the list at the Lakeland Center, there is no telling when we would be able to get back on the list. Plus there is an advantage to going back to the same location; you build relationships with the associates of the facility which some times nets better service and they already know what we want and expect at our events.

Other expenses at the convention include printing (program booklets, flyers, etc.), ribbons, decorations, etc. which is why we also sell vendor and booster ads for the program booklet, shirts, buttons, tote bags, etc.

The proceeds from each convention are then split equally between the Florida Federation, Florida Callers Association and the Round Dance Council of Florida. The Federation then splits the money equally between the five regional associations.

Now that you know the WHY, let's discuss the HOW. What is being done so far to raise money for 2010?

On Saturday, February 28<sup>th</sup>, there will be a Convention Benefit Dance at the Stardust Center in Plant City. Admittance will be a donation at the door. All of the proceeds will go to benefit the 2010 State Convention. Callers will be Bill Chesnut and Charlie Pergrossi and Lisa Wall will be cueing. This dance is being held in conjunction with the Florida Federation Working Weekend also being held at the Stardust Center that weekend.

West Coast has already started raising money by having the Themed Basket Silent Auction at the last Fall Fun Fest, which raised around \$800 to be donated towards the State Convention Fund. Don Slocum has also been so kind as to start selling Diners Club Cards for which the proceeds will also be donated to the Fund.

**But what else can we do? West Coast Association needs your help.** We need someone to be in charge of Ways & Means for the West Coast Association. This person(s) would be responsible for coordinating the fundraising efforts for our association. As you can see we are well on our way to raising our share. Some past fundraising activities have been special dances and raffles (TV, laptop, cruise etc.). We have several fundraising "experts" in our association who would be happy to answer any questions you may have. The theme for the 2010 Convention is "Every Day's a Holiday When You're Dancing", and each association has been assigned certain holidays. There will not be one convention outfit but each association will wear outfits for the holidays they have been assigned. West Coast was assigned Valentine's Day and St. Patrick's Day, so if you don't have outfits for these two holidays you might want to start collecting some so you will have enough for a whole weekend of dancing! There will be displays at the Benefit Dance on the 28<sup>th</sup> showing the themes for each of the associations. Each association will also be donating a themed basket for the silent auction to be held that weekend.

Each year when your club's new board takes office, it should be someone's responsibility to ensure that the listing in the <u>Dancer</u>, as well as other publications and websites, are updated.

If your club isn't already listed in the <u>Dancer</u>, your membership might want to consider having your club information listed. This is FREE advertising for your club!

- Advertisements There are various sizes of ads that can be purchased in the *DANCER*. On Thursday, September 3<sup>rd</sup>, an all day tour has been scheduled to the Amana Colonies. The bus leaves early in the morning from the Clarion. After a 90-minute drive, you will be transported to quaint villages that were established by a group of German immigrants. The bus will stop at the visitors' center for a bathroom break and welcoming speech. A local guide will then board the bus with the group and offer comments and stories as you visit several of the local craftsmen. The Amanas are home to a woolen mill, brewery, broom and basket shop, smokehouse, several wineries and bakeries, furniture and clockmaker, and a variety of other establishments. A family-style lunch will be served in one of the amazing German restaurants followed by free time to shop. The bus will return to the Clarion a couple hours before the Thursday evening dance so you have (a little) time to rest.

Moline is home to the world headquarters of John Deere, and the Friday morning tour will take in some of the local facilities of the company. Depending on production schedules, there may be a factory tour. If not, the tour will visit the World Headquarters and grounds. In addition, there will be a stop at the John Deere Pavilion and store.

Friday afternoon we will offer a 1 ½ - hour cruise on the Mississippi River aboard the Celebration Belle, a paddlewheel boat. Various sights will be noted by the captain. You can visit the wheelhouse, purchase a snack, or just enjoy the leisurely cruise and beautiful view.

Don and Doug Sprosty will be your hosts for the Saturday morning tour entitled "Dance in All Four Quad Cities". Participants will board the bus at the Clarion and step off in each city

(Moline, Rock Island, Davenport, and Bettendorf) to dance and do some fast sightseeing. Don and Doug will provide the calling, and all on the tour will get a souvenir dangle for the event.

The QC area is also home to the Rock Island Arsenal, a working military post and armaments factory. Saturday afternoon's tour will take you to the island. A guide will narrate a bus tour of the location that includes historic cemeteries, homes, and buildings. Entrance fees to the Mississippi River and Arsenal Museums are included in the price. Due to government regulations, only US citizens may take this tour.

Besides the arranged tours, we have: TPC Deere Run if you're a golfer, casino boats, walking paths along the river, the Figgie art museum, historic homes and gardens, the River Music Experience for jazz enthusiasts, the Putnam and IMAX, the River Bandits' baseball team, day trips to Dubuque or Galena or Waterloo (for more John Deere tractors!), and local favorites – the Isabel Bloom studios and Boetjes mustard factory tours. # Going Solo to a Convention?

Here are some tips to get a dance partner when you're solo at a convention:

- ✓ Get a "solo" ribbon and wear it everywhere the dance floor, the vendor area, the snack bar. You never know when someone may see you and realize you're available.
- ✓ Smile. Even if you're sitting out a dance, smile, tap your toes to the music, clap if its part of a dance in other words, participate from the sidelines. Show that you're enjoying yourself. After all, that's why you came, isn't it?
- ✓ Accept offers to dance. Maybe the individual isn't your first choice, but one dance won't hurt, and you might just end up in a square with someone who does strike your fancy.
- ✓ If you're a lady, dance with another lady if a square needs a couple. The idea is to get on the floor and dance. No one knows if you can dance as long as you sit.
- ✓ Chat with the person you're sitting with. Chat with people in the hall and on the elevator and on a tour bus. Make it easy for someone to approach you and ask you to dance.
- ✓ Know the calls, and know them well. If you don't, brush up *before* the convention. We all make an occasional mistake, but if you break down a square more than once, you'll

- find yourself sitting out a lot. On the other hand, it is absolutely exhilarating to have someone grab your hand and say, "Let's dance! I'm ready for a great square!"
- ✓ Last but not least, don't be shy. Remember that at a singles' convention, anyone can ask someone else to dance!



## Mission

ARTS continues to pursue its mission to generate public awareness and promote growth and acceptance of contemporary Square, Round, and Traditional Folk Dance by encouraging and assisting a coalition of allied dance groups. The ARTS will provide the leadership and resources necessary to create an achievable marketing program. The ARTS will encourage, promote, and support healthy

lifestyles through dance programs and events which provide fun and effective exercise for both mind and body, all within a unique system of social interactions.

## Cooperation

In an effort to achieve this ambitious mission unprecedented cooperation has been established among the leadership of the Dance community.

- - An unprecedented atmosphere of cooperation, collaboration, and communications has been created by bringing together CALLERLAB, CONTRALAB, the International Association of Gay Square Dance Clubs (IAGSDC), the National Executive Committee of the National Square Dance Convention® (NEC), the National Square Dance Campers Associations (NSDCA), ROUNDALAB, the Single Square Dancers USA (SSDUSA), The United Square Dancers of America (USDA), the USAWest Square Dance Convention® (USAWest), to establish the Alliance of Round, Traditional, and Square-Dance, Inc. ARTS Dance Governing Board.
- - In addition to the Governing Board organizations, the ARTS has brought together a number of influential organizations to form the ARTS Auxiliary Governing Board. Organizations which have affiliated with the ARTS include the following: US Handicapable Square Dance Association,

Kentucky Dance Foundation, Lloyd Shaw Foundation, National Association of Square and Round Dance Suppliers, and Square Dance Foundation of New England.

- - Additionally, there have been more than one hundred Individual and Associate (clubs, associations, etc.)

#### Members

- - The ARTS web site has been established at www.arts-dance.org to provide a wide variety of information to those interested in the activities of this organization. The web site includes information on all aspects of the ARTS. Mission Statement, Development Initiatives, Articles of Incorporation, Bylaws, Minutes of ARTS meetings, Members, Contributors, and links to each of the Governing Board member organizations. As new achievements are accomplished by the ARTS, the information is posted on the ARTS website.
- - The ARTS has teamed with YTB Travel to offer a way for dancers to book travel (transportation, hotels, rental cars, cruises, etc.) on line. The cost for online bookings is comparable to other online travel services. A small portion of the cost is donated back to the activity through the ARTS. - - An informational brochure was initially developed in 2004 and has been updated repeatedly since then. This brochure provides information about the ARTS in a convenient tri-fold format. The recently updated brochure will be distributed in the registration packets at the 58th NSDC in Long Beach CA.
- - An ARTS Email Tree is in development. This Email tree will provide an electronic distribution system which will provide the means for sending information to every dance club which has a Member with Email. There are now nearly 30 Email Tree Contacts who cover over 20 different states. The effort to complete this Email Tree continues. The ARTS is an IRS 501 © (3) tax-exempt corporation incorporated in North Carolina. Donations to the ARTS may be deductible on US tax returns. Please ask your tax preparer to verify your status.
- - The ARTS meets three times a year to consider, discuss, and vote on issues brought to the group. The meetings are typically held in February/March, June, and October. - - During the 2008 Fall ARTS meeting in Orlando, FL the Board elected the following officers to oversee the activities of the ARTS for the next year: Chairman Cathy Smith, Vice Chairman, Jim Weber, Treasurer Edythe Weber, and Secretary Jerry Reed.

### **Education**

As an IRS 501 © (3) organization, the ARTS is recognized for its educational benefits.

- - During 2008 the ARTS participated in the Education program at the 57th NSDC in Wichita, KS. This participation included two education seminars: 1) Ready, Set, Go Tell Us What You Expect from ARTS. This session offered a forum for idea sharing and discussion of projects currently being implemented by the ARTS and 2) The Race is On" ARTS and the Future of Our Activity. Over the years, ARTS has been watching, listening and researching the state of our dance activity. In this seminar, the results of which will be presented, along with projects being explored to increase participation in our dance activity.
- - The ARTS continues to support Square Dance 101, a comprehensive workbook designed for teachers or youth group leaders who want to teach Modern Western Square Dancing. This package is available through the ARTS web site at: <a href="https://www.arts-dance.org">www.arts-dance.org</a>.

#### **Projects**

The ARTS continues to look at projects to help meet the organization's mission:

addition to the other topics, the seminars MUST also cover who and what ARTS is, its purposes, goals, and accomplishments.
