Twirling

Some women do not want to be twirled; and if they don't want to be, they will either tell you verbally or will wear a badge stating this or when they come to you in the circle, their hand will be down indicating they do not want you to swing them.


Men: When you do twirl a woman, be gentle. You do not have to do anything other than hold your hand up for her to use to balance herself while twirling her, you can cause back, arm and shoulder injuries if this is doesn't correctly. One twirl is all that is needed.

Square Dancing

Psst – well it's no secret; square dancing is one of the best all-around activities for all age groups! Wait a minute, how can anything with the word "square" being part of it be all that

great. Well modern western square dancing is not quite what you may have learned in school. This puppy rocks!

It's a party every time you go as it brings people together for fun and fellowship – even during class lessons. The fun starts right from the beginning, meeting new people and making new friends and continues the more you dance.

Square dancing's motto is "Friendship Set to Music" and the music is very diverse. From golden oldies to current hits, Broadway show tunes, country, and even gospel, square dance music in singing calls covers them all. Patter or hash as it is sometimes called usually features music with a strong down beat. Believe it or not, one caller even used "Hooked on Classics" as patter music in square dancing. Nothing quite like swinging to the "Flight of the Bumblebee".

Square dance tips as they are referred to usually consist of two parts. During the first part of the tip the caller will use patter or hash calls for the dancers to execute. The dancers do not know which calls are coming next so naturally listening is very important. The caller may use certain combinations of calls which he or she intends to use in the second half of the tip which is a singing call. The singing call will be to a song which is usually very recognizable to the dancers. Most square dance callers feature excellent singing voices and are very entertaining. The "tip" derives its name from long ago when following each dance set the caller placed his hat down and dancers would deposit money in it and in that way the caller was paid.

Square dancing is not only fun, but healthy too! Dancing is a recommended activity of the President's Council on Physical Fitness. No specific type of dancing is mentioned but square dancing with its combination of constant movement and quick directional changes is obviously a low impact activity which helps keep the body in shape. While dancing may not provide all the conditioning a person needs it can sure help. It's estimated that square dancers may cover as much as five miles during a typical two or two and a half hour dance burn up to 500 calories.

Another health benefit is the social component that solitary fitness activities lack. During a typical square dance, dancers meet and interact with many others as there are eight dancers in each square. This opportunity to develop strong social ties contributes to self-esteem and a positive outlook – all in an alcohol and smoke free environment.

Square dancing is a unique American heritage dance. It is the official folk dance of the United States and is practiced in many countries of the world. English is used for all square dance calls even though the caller and dancer in foreign countries may not speak it. Governor Charlie Crist recognized September as Square Dance Month as it usually marks the beginning of a new square dance season.

Most every country with a folk dance features costumes that reflect their culture. Modern western square dancing features dance attire with a western flair that attests to some of it frontier roots. Jeans, long-sleeve western style shirts often featuring collar points, colorful

scarves or bolo ties are available for guys. Dresses with crinolines or skirt and blouse combinations have been traditional for the ladies. However, dress codes have greatly relaxed over the years, especially for the gals. Prairie skirts and slacks are approved now, and actually, the emphasis is on relaxed, comfortable attire. Most square dance clubs subscribe to casual dress during the summer, some even feature it at most dances year round.

To add to the variety of the square dance activity, many clubs also include round dancing in their programs. Rounds are couples dancing to choreographed steps by a cuer. These dances include a variety of rhythms including two-step, waltz, foxtrot, rumba, and cha-cha.

Square Dance Do's and Don'ts

Some things are worth repeating!

- **DO** be aware at all times that square dancing is a "courtesy" recreation rather than one of competition.
- **DO** keep smiling even if you are angry with yourself for "goofing". The other seven people in the square might think that you are frowning at them.
- **DO** recognize your corner and remember who he or she is. Next to your partner this is the most important person in the square.
- be quiet and attentive to the caller during instructions even though you know what he is explaining. Perhaps someone else in your square needs to be briefed.
- **DO** leave sharp jewelry at home. It can cut fingers or catch on clothes and inflict injury.
- **DO** remember to treat all dancers as you would like to be treated.
- wear name badges at all times. It might surprise some of the oldsters to learn that they are not as well known as they thought. Many dancers are not aware of the origin of the name badge. When western style square dancing began to flourish, someone suggested that everyone should be identified by means of a name badge so that dancers would be on a first name basis to further friendly fellowship and recreation. Some clubs decided to add their club name and city or area where it was located. They also created original designs for their badges. THE RUDE SQUARE DANCER IS THE ONE WITHOUT A BADGE,

- because this places other dancers in the embarrassing position of not being able to call a name. DON'T BE CAUGHT BEING RUDE.
- admit it when you "goof". Next time it could be someone else's turn, so you needn't feel bad about it. When you "goof", do it gracefully and recover as best you can in order to keep your square from breaking down.
- remember your position when you square up heads, sides, what couple number, and in some instances whether you are in a boy or girl position.
- **DO** end each dance with a flourish, applause, and sincere THANKS to all in your square.
- **DON'T** be a "competitive" dancer. Instead cooperate with the other seven people in your set to make a good square.
- **DON'T** be over-exuberant. Your yell might drown out the next call for everyone around you. Learn to be "noisy", if you must, at the right time during a right and left grand or allemande.
- **DON'T** be a "know-it-all". Let the caller be the instructor unless someone asks you for help at the close of a tip.
- **DON'T** but in or out of a square unless you know how. And if you are cut out, leave gracefully.
- **DON'T** be guilty of "horseplay" unless you are positive your square and the club will not be offended.
- **DON'T** take that extra swing with your partner. It might make them late for the left allemande with the waiting corner.
- **DON'T** forget. It is the woman who determines whether or not they wish to twirl. If their hand is held high, they would like to twirl. If it is low, then they do not wish to twirl.
- **DON'T** forget to trade a dance, especially with the guests. And don't overlook the caller's spouse and solos. They might like to dance. ASK THEM!
- **DON'T** Sit like a "bump on a log" when another couple is needed to complete a square. If you want to sit out a tip, leave the floor go to the rest room or where you cannot be seen. This prevents embarrassment to you and to the three couples wishing to square up.
- **DON'T** complain about the caller, the hall, the sound, the tacky floor. Seek to find the good things about the dance and express them. Your attitude will contribute to your enjoyment as well as to the enjoyment of others around you.

- **DON'T** pre-arrange sets of four couples before squaring up. You insult the ability of other dancers and reflect a snobbish image contrary to the democratic ideals square dancers which to exemplify. If you wish to dance with friends, you and another couple could stand in opposite positions in the set and allow two other couples to join you.
- **DON'T** insist on dancing your way when visiting other areas. If these people dance palms up on the Alamo, go along with it. If they do or do not stir the bucket, DO AS THE ROMANS DO EAT ROMAN CANDLES but keep your opinions to yourself.
- **DON'T** try to help the caller when filling in with a new class by explaining or pushing or pulling. Dance as though it is your first night too.
- **DON'T** PARTAKE OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES BEFORE OR DURING THE DANCE! Some people object; others may not wish to be close to one with alcohol on his breath. Children are often present, and many clubs dance in churches or schools. Drinking may even adversely affect your dancing ability. This is a cardinal rule of square dancing.
- **DON'T** be "breath offensive"! Ask a friend for gum or mints if you forget yours.
- **DON'T** forget to use a deodorant after your pre-dance bath or shower. You may become quite warm when you are dancing.
- **DON'T** be a ROUGH HANDLER. Use light, easy handholds; that is, don't grab or squeeze tight on box-the-gnats, grand right and lefts, circling, etc.

Why do we...

NOT DRINK ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES AT DANCES?

Alcohol inhibits our ability to learn and perform. Alcohol reduces our reaction time making us a poorer dancer. In addition, square dancing is a wholesome, family-oriented activity.

BELONG TO A CLUB?

Clubs are needed to organize dances and establish a means to enjoy the fellowship of square dancing. To survive they need an active membership where everyone helps. Volunteer, don't wait to be asked!

STAY NON-COMPETITIVE?

In square dancing we want everyone to have fun, so without winners and losers, this can be accomplished.

OVERLOOK MISTAKES BY OTHERS?

We all make mistakes. Everyone is trying to do it right. Encourage them!

WEAR NAME BADGES?

Badges enable us to be on a first name basis which furthers friendly fellowship.

WELCOME NEW DANCERS?

New dancers are the lifeblood of our activity! Only with their enthusiasm and ideas can dancing continue to flourish!
