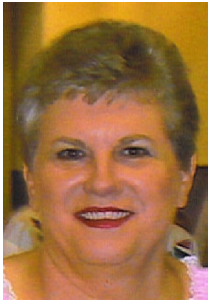

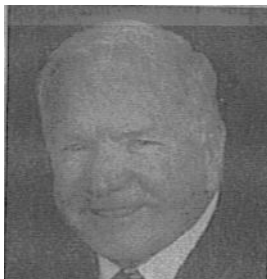

Back in Time

Another trip down memory lane! This is from the January 1953 issue of the *Bow & Swing*

"All Florida Square and Folk Dancers and Callers should reserve April 11. That is the date set for the first Annual Florida Square and Folk Dance Festival, to be held in Tampa.

Don Armstrong is chairman of the Festival Committee in charge of all arrangements.

This is the first big event to be sponsored by the Florida Square and Folk Dance Callers and Teachers Association, and local groups should begin now to make plans to attend.

While the committee has not perfected plans to the point of releasing much publicity yet, it is known that several nationally known callers will be present and take part, besides a large number of Florida callers.

Watch for more details in the February, March, and April issues. But begin now to develop interest in your own community."

In 1953, the *Bow & Swing* was published ten times a year and was \$1 a year for a subscription!

"Ft. Pierce has a Midget Square Dance very Saturday morning, 9:30 – 11:00 a.m., for those 12 and under. The caller is Richard (Dickie) Bird, 11 years old. Music, records."

"The invitation of the City of Tampa has been accepted for the second annual Florida Square and Folk Dance Festival according to Bill Embryo, president of the Florida Square and Folk Dance Callers and Teachers Association.

The invitation, extended by Mrs. Cordelia Hunt, Superintendent of Recreation for Tampa, again makes the fine facilities of the city available, for this event.

In spite of the fact that we felt the Festival should be moved around the state from year to year, we are delighted with this invitation and its acceptance. Many of the places which would be desirable from point of view of location simply do not have the facilities available to handle a large Festival of this type. Tampa does. Likewise, Tampa has a large nucleus of local dancers, a Square Dance minded City Recreation Department, and a desire for the Festival.

So far as location is concerned, Tampa is about as close to the extremities of the state as could be found.

Date for the Festival have been set for April 2, 3, and 4. This cuts the time for preparation, especially as regards getting out publicity to dancers in various areas. But we believe that willing and active committees will start functioning at once and can get the job done.

At least one planning meeting will be held during January, to lay the general plans and get local and statewide committees started.

As last year, the main Festival Dance is planned for Saturday night, with a Friday night pre-Festival dance, and Saturday workshops, and with special meetings, especially that of the callers association, scheduled for Sunday April 3. More detailed plans will be announced in our next issue, and by letters sent out to other publications.

Begin to plan now to attend this event.

Mark those dates on your calendar.”
