

Two People from West Coast Win the Extra Mile Award

We were so pleased to hear at the State Convention that two people from the Suncoast Callers & Cuers Association won the Extra Mile Award this year!

The Extra Mile Award is presented by the Florida Federation to a caller or cuer who has gone the extra mile to promote square and/or round dancing.

Following are the nominations:

Some volunteers in our activity are quiet, work hard to promote our activity, quietly fill in where they are needed and you don't hear their name very much. These are the dependable workers that never receive the recognition that they should.

This cuer lives in the West Coast Association area, and although since she is a cuer and a member of the Suncoast Callers and Cuers Association and can't hold an office in the West Coast Square and Round Dancers Association, still attends the majority of the Folding/Business Meetings. For several years, she was the circulation chairman for the *West Coast Dancer* which meant arriving at the meeting early with large bags labeled and prepared to "receive" the copies of the *Dancer* to be distributed out to our clubs through our established relay system.

She attends every West Coast Membership Dance within a two-hour drive of her home and volunteers her time as a cuer for the dances. She is always willing to fill in for other cuers in times of sickness, death and vacations.

This cuer is single but she can dance both sides up to C-3B, so she is always willing to step in and dance the "man's" part to ensure that the women are getting to dance and to fill in a square.

Pat Hagen was born in California and has been dancing for 57 years. She moved to Florida from Indiana 24 years ago. She has one son. Two cockatiels reside in her home in Clearwater. In years past, Pat has worked in sales, i.e. Yellow Pages, sold cars and taught ballroom dancing at Arthur Murray Studios.

She was president of the Round Dance Council of Florida in 1991. She is serving as a neighborhood watch representative and officer for her neighborhood. She is currently the vice president of the Suncoast Callers and Cuers Association, an office she has held for several years, and she is a member of the Round Dance Council of Florida. She is also currently a home healthcare giver. You can't keep a worker idle!

Pat wasn't at the convention, so I accepted the award on her behalf and presented it to her at the Folding Meeting last Wednesday.

This caller moved to the West Coast Association area close to ten years ago from the northeast. I believe the first caller he contacted when he arrived was Bob Barnes. I was looking for a caller to do a demo at my office in Orlando but no one was available so Bob put me in touch with him. I called him, he came, we had two squares of Orlando Singles dancers, lots of interested Marriott associates and we had a fun afternoon.

On many occasions he has donated his time to call at the West Coast Membership Dances. He has also assisted with many demonstrations and was instrumental with starting a new club in the Lake Wales area.

When one of our dancers in Polk County was approached about starting a square dance program at a local elementary school, this caller was approached about conducting the lessons. For eight weeks, he showed up on Monday for an 8:00 a.m. class, another one around lunch time and one at the end of the school day. This meant he was tied up at the school the entire day. He taught third, fourth and fifth graders the history of square dancing and some of the fundamental steps. At the end of the eight weeks, they held a Parents' Night so the students could show their parents what they had learned and get their parents involved.

Keith Stevens moved here from State College, Pennsylvania, with his wife, Margot and they live in Lake Wales. He is past president of the Suncoast Callers and Cuers Association and a member of the Florida Callers Association.

Working with some other people (and Margot), we had Keith in the hall on time and we surprised him!

Reprint from *Bow & Swing* – June 2009

Want to help raise money for the 2010 Convention and earn money yourself? It's easy; just purchase a Grocery Certificate for \$50. \$33 of that will go to the 2010 Convention and \$17 will be sent in to the company. That's the fundraising for the convention; now how do you earn money?

- 1. You register your certificate's unique pass code with the name of your favorite grocery store and you will receive a redemption certificate for the following month.
- 2. Starting next month you visit your selected store and make your usual purchases. Save your original receipts until you have a total of at least \$100. NO TWO (2) RECEIPTS CAN BE ON THE SAME DAY. Your receipts must show 50% or more as consumable food products, including cat and dog food, for the grocery certificates. The remainder may be anything else that the store sells.
- 3. Once you have \$100 or more in receipts, put them in an envelope with your redemption certificate for that month and mail them to the address shown on your redemption certificate. The postmark MUST BE NO LATER than the last day of the month for which you are submitting.
- 4. Receipts cannot be carried over from one month to the next...they all must be for the month you are submitting. Once your redemption certificate and receipts are received and approved, you will receive a \$25 Visa Debit Card in the return mail. You may spend this \$25 anywhere you like or give it as a gift to someone special. (Here's where you earn the money. If you submit your receipts every month you can earn \$300!)
- 5. If you do not get your receipts in on time, you will lose the opportunity to receive the \$25 rebate for that month. The recommendation is....send in more than \$100 in receipts, double check to see that you do not have two (2) receipts on the same day and mail them as soon as you have accumulated the \$100 or more in receipts...don't wait for the last day of the month!

Now that the State Convention is truly an all-state convention, where the entire state is involved in planning and putting on the convention each year, we will be fundraising every year to contribute our (West Coast Association) portion of the funds that are needed to meet the expenses of having a state convention.



Back in 1910 John Bossidy made this memorable quote:

"And this is good old Boston, The home of the bean and the cod, Where the Lowells talk to the Cabots, And the Cabots talk only to God."

This was aimed at snobbery. Are some square dancers becoming Lowells and Cabots? Skill Snobbery seems to be rearing its ugly head, especially with the new popularity of more advance forms of square dancing.

When we were taking our basic lessons, we were urged (or should have been urged) by our caller to "mix and mingle". This is where the camaraderie starts that makes square dancing such an enjoyable activity. You suddenly find you have an enormous circle of friends, all struggling to achieve the goal of becoming accomplished Mainstream Dancers. This "mixing and mingling" also helps keep the entire class near the same level of accomplishment.

Sometimes at Plus Workshops – and this gets more pronounced at the Advanced level where more than one club may be involved – a square of dancers from one club, or one area, may decide to attend a Workshop together. To be charitable, we might say they are too shy to square up with strangers in the new environment. In some cases, however, these people do not wish to square up with others for fear the others may not be apt learners, and they might not be getting their "money's worth." This group then becomes a little clique, and even in their home club, they may continue with their "pat square". They may even go so far as to keep their eyes open to find other dancers they think might be "eligible" for the "honor" of being asked to join them should one of their couples be ill or on vacation.

Maybe they are getting their "money's worth". Maybe they are having fun. But they miss one of the best advantages of square dancing – friendship. Their circle of friends becomes very limited. Sometimes other dancers will shun them for their lack of club spirit. Some, when asked if they will square up with a "pat square" in the next tip, will even politely decline and say they do not believe in planning squares in advance's

We note some callers resort to passing out numbers to couples as they enter, and make up random squares to discourage this practice. This is more prevalent in the Advanced and Challenge groups. These callers are to be commended. They not only help ALL the dancers to have fun, but theirs are the clubs that are more apt to grow and prosper. These clubs also have more visitors, because they are made to feel welcome even if they do not have the skills of the best dancers in the club they are visiting.

DANCERS – if you are guilty of planning your squares in advance, you may think yourselves to be the best square on the floor, but you not only miss out on the friendship and love available through square dancing, but on another benefit. There is nothing more pleasing than the feeling you get when you have a "weak" couple in your square, and though it's a struggle, still manage to get everyone to their corner when that all important "Left Allemande" is called. You feel good – and the "Weak" couple feels great! It can be the best tip of the night.

CALLERS – Keep your eyes open for "pat squares" sneaking into your club. Do something about it – for the sake of square dancing – for your club's sake – for the dancer's sake – for your sake – and for the sake – for goodness sake.

Knothead Knews

It's hard to believe but we're working on plans for the 50th Annual Knothead Konvention. We have booked the dates of Friday, February 19 and Saturday, February 20, 2010 at the Eau Gallie Civic Center in Melbourne.

For your dancing pleasure we have National Caller Ken Ritucci from West Springfield, Massachusetts. He's been asked to keep you and your feet dancing these two special days. Not only that, but we've also arranged to have National Cuer Larry Chatos, (originally from Ohio) now residing in West Palm Beach, to keep the round dancers happily dancing the entire weekend. I've had the pleasure of dancing to Larry at several National Conventions and he was terrific.

Larry started square dancing at age 12 and by 16 he started round dancing. Those Ohio dancers are great (just ask SusanElaine and me). In 1988 while still in high school, he became a professional cuer, cueing for three clubs in Northwest Ohio and Southeast Michigan. In six months Larry was asked to cue for the Buckeye Square & Round Dance Convention in Columbus.

In 1992 Florida was beckoning and Larry moved to West Palm Beach. In 1996 he started teaching round dancing and graduated 20 couples in his first class. He met Nancy in 1997 at the SunCat Square Dance Club in Stuart and they married in 1999.

Larry and Nancy also cue for the Sailfish Squares in Stuart and the NSD Campers Chapter 080. He has cued for several state conventions in Ohio and Florida, plus several National Conventions, and an International Camporee.

If your club is interested, arrange for your caller or club president to locate a club over 100 miles from your club, go there and dance, come back the same night, and you're qualified as a Knothead. Send for an application at the Knothead office (flaknothead@bellsouth.net). Square and round dancing is scheduled for Friday afternoon and evening, followed by skits. Saturday morning Larry will teach some easy round dances to any and all dancers interested. He'll have more rounds in the afternoon. Ken will have square dancing in the other room. Knothead initiation will be at 2:00 p.m. Saturday. You won't want to miss this! Caller SusanElaine is the official "Knothead Knotter". That evening there will be an "Idiot" Square Dance Party. Again you won't want to miss this! We'll have vendors for you're your shopping pleasure. Plus it's the 50th Annual Knothead Konvention. I wonder what the organizers have up their sleeve for this.
