From the Editor



Can you believe we're already in the middle of June? Where has this year gone?

Some of our dancers have already headed out for the 58th National Square Dance Convention in Long Beach, CA as they are making stops along the way to visit with family and sightsee along the way. Others will be leaving next week as the Convention starts on the 24th.

As of Saturday, June 13th, there are 53 dancers from Florida registered for the convention. We are 16th highest for the number of registrations. There are a total of 4,614 dancers registered. I found it interesting that there are people from Sweden (42), Japan (38), Germany (30), Taiwan (17), United Kingdom (7), Australia (6), Belgium (6), Denmark (6), Phillipines (6), Finland (2), Norway (2) and Saudia Arabia (2) registered, and some of these aren't small numbers.

You have been reading about the competition that will be held this year; well, Florida will be represented by one square consisting of Don and Ann Slocum (Bartow), Ray and Elsa Huddleston (Tamarac), Bill and Joanne Boyd (Apopka), Cliff Reiss (Riverview) and me (Auburndale). There are currently only six squares registered to participate in this competition.

If you will be driving out to Long Beach, you will want to check the Looking Ahead page on the website to find all the Trail Thru Dances along the way.

With the rollout of my new website (www.squaredancefan.com) last week, you will note that the DANCERgram is a lot shorter this week. I no longer have to email the "Looking Ahead" section each week; it is now listed on the website. Now that the newsletter is shorter, it will be easier for you to print off copies for distribution at your dances. This is also a good reference tool to refer to when making announcements of upcoming dances in the area and also to receive current information from the West Coast Association and Florida Federation.

Be sure to check out the website every so often as we continue to add more content and try to enhance the look to make it a useful tool for all the dancers.

Did you know that vehicle/vessel registration fees will be going up by 60% effective September 1, 2009. You can go to the Tax Collector's office three months prior to your expiration (through November 2009 renewal date) and purchase your renewals before the fees increase. You don't need the renewal notice. Please take a list of the license plate numbers and proof of insurance. You can also purchase two renewals/years (2010 and 2011) at that time for a significant price break. This is only available through August 31, 2009. The different birth month renewals can be processed up to three months in advance.

Herky Jerky

Sometimes when people are square dancing, they get so caught up in the moment and they think they are right when a call is called by the caller that they grab the person next to them and try to take them or force them into the direction that they believe is correct. Unfortunately when two people do this, it is sometimes two different directions at the same time!!! Several times in the last month or so I have witnessed that someone in the middle of an "Ocean Wave" was jerked into a direction that their partner thought was correct. It was only seconds later when that partner realized they were wrong. Needless to say that person's rotator cuff was stretched to where it shouldn't have been stretched to and it does hurt!!!!

Please be kind and gentle with your partner and remember not to "jerk them around" to where you THINK they should be. We all make mistakes, but please remember your mistake could seriously injure your dancing partner.

A special note to those who dance the "boy's" position; please don't "man handle" or "jerk" the person dancing in the "girl's" position. They might be slightly off step or out of position but you're grabbing or jerking them into the correct position, swinging them hard and tight, could seriously injure that person. Remember that we are here to have fun and it is **NOT** fun to be jerked, pushed, prodded or flung into the correct position. Happy dancing everyone!!!
