

Florida Hall of Fame

NOMINATION DEADLINE: JANUARY 15, 2011

The deadline for submitting nominations for the Florida Hall of Fame is fast approaching, so I thought I would provide you with some information on this award e.g. history, nomination process, who's eligible, etc.



The Hall of Fame was organized to honor dancers, callers, cuers, publishers, teachers, organizers, promoters and/or vendors for their contributions made to the dance activity **statewide**. The Hall of Fame became a reality

due to the work of Chet and Julia Vetter, Mori and Phyllis Sogolo, Art and Martha Springer and Marty and Birdie Martin. The first inductees were made May 19, 1983 at the state convention. The square dance hall at Strawberry Square became the permanent home of the Hall of Fame at a Grand Opening dance held on December 4, 1983. At the State Convention, new members are presented with a small plaque to keep and a larger plaque is installed at Strawberry Square Hall for public viewing.

As of the State Convention in the year 2004, 74 inductees have been installed in the Florida Hall of Fame. These inductees consist of dancers, callers, cuers, publishers and vendors. Some have qualified in two categories.

Display cases for past presidents of the Florida Federation of Square and Round Dancers, the Florida Callers Association and the Round Dance Council of Florida have been provided by the Hall of Fame Committee. Each of the five area associations have a plaque displaying persons from their area who have been honored as person or couple of the year. An additional plaque lists the State Convention General Chairman and Caller Chairman and Cuer Chairman for each of the State conventions.

The Hall of Fame is financed through funds derived from State Conventions. The three sponsoring associations, Florida Federation, Callers Association and Round Dance Council, each contribute one-third (1/3) of the expenses.

The Selection Committee is a group of dancers, callers and cuers from every area of the state and both sexes are represented. These are known only to the Hall of Fame Committee and not to each other. Members of the Selection Committee must have been active in the Florida dance activity for at least 10 years, have visited and danced in a number of areas within the state and be knowledgeable of what is going on. Voting is done in secret by sending resumes and ballots to each voting member; ballots are completed and returned to the Hall of Fame Committee Chairman without revealing the name and address of the voter. The ballots are opened in the presence of a quorum of the Hall of Fame Committee.

The fact that one is nominated is a very high honor, whether or not they enter the Hall of Fame.

Preparing a nominating resume will take some time and investigation to make it complete. Talk to other dancers, callers and/or cuers for dates,

places and times the nominee was involved in statewide participation. Follow the who, what, when and where rule as you investigate and prepare the resume. The more information submitted, the better.

Once the resume is finished there are two ways in which to present the information to the Hall of Fame Committee. The resume may be submitted to the board of directors of any of the five area associations, Callers Association or Cuers Association. The area or association board of directors will review the resume and vote to reject or pass it on to the Hall of Fame Committee. The resume may also be sent to the Hall of Fame Committee chairman. Resumes must be received by the Hall of Fame committee by January 15th of each year. It is suggested that any association not submit more than two resumes for consideration per year. The Hall of Fame Committee shall meet and review all resumes presented and vote by secret ballot to forward such resumes to the Selection Committee for the final vote.

All resumes should be submitted to the chairman of the Hall of Fame Committee on or before January 15th.

president as chairman of same. New members coming on will replace the ones going off.



- 3) The selection committee meets during the February working weekend to review the nominee(s) and arrive at a final decision.

Procedure for Presenting Award/Awards

The award(s) should be

presented on Saturday evening at the Florida State Square and Round Dance Convention held in May of the same year, by the current president of the Florida Federation.

2) The award(s) presented shall be a framed document and an "Extra Mile Award Recipient" bar or dangle.

Have you been looking for a 21st Century "New Age" recruiting tool? Many of us have been looking for a web based tool to help us recruit new dancers. Well, IT IS HERE!! The ARTS has created a web site and videos which are intended to help you recruit dancers to Square Dancing, Round Dancing, or Contra Dancing. This tool is You2CanDance.com.

The You 2 Can Dance web site which can be viewed at www.you2candance.com is up and operational. Launched at the 2010 National Square Dance Convention in Louisville, KY in June 2010, all three videos (Squares, Rounds, and Contra) are there for viewing, as well as detailed explanations of these three dance forms. The "find a caller" section has been initiated, with information for over 2,000 callers available. The Cuer and Club listings are next. The callers were added first because a database with most of the known callers in North America was available. Unfortunately, the same cannot be said for cuers or clubs.

This will get your club's info added to the site much quicker. The same is also true for round dance leader associations. Listed below are ways to use the new web site to help promote dancing in your area. If you have any additional ideas, please send them to Roy Gotta.

How to Use You 2 Can Dance

- 1. Make you2candance.com your home page. Every time you go on line, you will register a "hit" to the site. This helps it move to the earlier pages when someone does a search.
- 2. If you have a web site, be sure to add a link to this site. The number of links to a web site is a major factor in moving it to the first few pages of search engines.
- 3. Make sure you are listed on the web site, whether you are a caller, cuer, or club. If you have a web site, we will put a link to your site. If you have an email address, we will put a link to it for immediate contact by a visitor to the site. Send data to info@you2candance.com.

- 4. Everywhere you can, advertise "you2candance.com". It is a non threatening, no pressure way to get people to check us out, and no one will bother you unless you choose to be a contact. Put a little sign in one of your car's rear windows. Just you2candance.com, nothing else. You don't have to put your phone number or any explanation. If enough people do this, eventually people will visit the site, just to see what it's all about. Print up business cards that just say www.you2candance.com. Leave them laying around in waiting rooms, libraries, on supermarket bulletin board, anywhere someone might just pick it up and say "What the heck is this?" Make up a banner and hang it outside where you dance, or when you do a demo.
- 5. Use this web site on your flyers for open houses or other recruiting literature. People unfamiliar with the dance activity can watch a video of actual dancers and listen to a description of the activity given by a professional voice-over artist.
- 6. This web site isn't by any means the only tool you will need to help our activities grow. It is, however, another weapon to put in your arsenal. ARTS-Dance has created this to help you educate the public about what it is that we enjoy so much.

Remember, the more times someone sees something, hears something, comes into contact with something, the more likely they are to at least give it a try. After all, that's all we're asking, just give us a try.
