We always appreciate having "angels" help out at our classes, but sometimes as angels we sometimes need to be reminded that

- there is only one instructor at the class; so let him/her do the teaching
- no one can talk and listen at the same time; so when the instructor is talking, everyone should be silent
- no one can listen to more than one person at a time; the students should only be listening to the instructor
- the instructor should be allowed to finish explaining a move <u>before</u> the dancers execute it. The dancers should quietly remain in place while the instructor is explaining a movement; when the explanation is completed, the caller will call the movement and the dancers can then execute it.
- just because you have been dancing for many years, it doesn't mean you know the CALLERLAB definition of all the calls. Definitions have changed over the years and experienced dancers are notorious for taking shortcuts; so don't attempt to teach the new dancers the way you execute a move.
- just as the students are instructed to be gentle with arm and hand holds and twirls, angels should remember the same thing; don't jerk and pull the new dancers around.
- don't be a show off with your twirls, jumps, bumps and kicks; this only confuses the new dancers. These kinds of extra moves sometimes turn the new dancer around and they don't know what position they are in or what direction to go in. The new dancers already have a lot to learn and don't need the extra burden of learning all these extra steps that experienced dancers have decided to add to the activity. Basically, DON'T TWIRL, JUMP, BUMP OR KICK DURING CLASS!
- these new dancers need to be welcomed just like any experienced dancers visiting your dance. Invite the new dancers to sit with you and get to know them. If you don't make them feel welcome, why would they have any interest in joining your club?

I hope you will see the benefit of discussing these reminders at your classes. We all know these things but sometimes we need to be reminded about them.

#### Florida Callers Association

I started thinking the other day about how many callers we've lost in the past few years, and it made me stop and wonder: where are the new callers? We talk all the time about the decline in the number of dancers and the fact that classes get smaller and smaller each year. I wonder how many of us realize that the calling population is suffering the same fate at the same rate.

New callers are an important part of Square Dancing, and in the past each new year-group of dancers would eventually provide its share of new callers. New callers bring new ideas, new people, and new enthusiasm to the activity. I look at some of the recent new callers in the FCA and am excited to see what they have already added to Square Dancing in Florida.

But we still need more. In a state the size of Florida, with the variety of dancing it offers, there should more than three or four apprentice callers in the FCA training program at any time. Each year we bring in some of the top national calling talent to help our new callers. This past October it was Tom Miller from Pennsylvania and he was exceptional as a teacher and coach. Unfortunately, you could count on the fingers of one hand the number of truly new callers who were there to take advantage of this wonderful opportunity.

In spite of what some people may think, most callers are always ready to help someone get started. Every one of us on stage today had a mentor or teacher who helped us learn the craft. I know I speak for the majority of the Florida Callers Association when I say we'd like to return the favor.

If you've ever thought about calling, now is the time to step up and act. Square Dancing needs new callers and your new ideas in the worst way. Sure, it takes some time and practice to learn to call. But it took time and practice to learn to dance, too. The FCA has a great training program; all you need to do is join!

So, don't be shy, just do it. Ask any of your local FCA callers for some tips to get started. You'll be amazed at how much help you'll get.

The Federation meeting on Saturday and Sunday, February 27 and 28 is referred to as the "Working Weekend." It begins with the Federation meeting on Saturday morning. At the end of this meeting, committee assignments are finalized, and these committees get together after lunch for their breakout sessions. There is always a Saturday night dance in conjunction with the Federation meetings, and the dance on February 27 is a Benefit Dance for the 2011 State Convention. This dance will be at the Whirl & Twirl Club in Orlando.
