History of the Florida State Square & Round Dance Conventions

The first Florida State Convention (Square and Folk Dance Festival) was held on April 10, 11, & 12, 1953 in Tampa. Several national and international figures were present, including "Pappy" Lloyd Shaw, Doc Alumbaugh (founder of Winsor Records), the Chans of New York and Collettes of Atlanta (international figures in Folk and Round Dance), Ed Durlacher, and Jimmy Clossin. Don & Marie Armstrong, nationally known caller and cuer, were General Chairman of the event.

The Florida Federation of Square Dancers was formed in November of 1957 with one of the reasons being the hope of bidding for a National Convention. At that time it consisted of four associations; Southeast, formed in February of 1956, Northeast in January of 1957, Central, in February of 1957 and the West Coast in October of 1957. Later in November of 1972 they were joined by the Northwest forming a federation of five associations.

In May of 1958 the 7th Florida State Convention at Miami Beach was a joint effort of the Florida Callers and the Federation. The first six had been staged by the callers and they were turning it over to the dancers so they could gain the necessary experience to meet the requirements for bidding. The first bid in Denver in 1959 was not successful as it was awarded to Detroit but the next year at Des Moines Harry Moore and his host of friends and fellow workers were awarded the bid for 1962.

For the next nine years several formats for the convention were tried and in 1972 a plan came into operation that has proven quite successful for over 35 years. With seed money and guidelines from a Coordinating Committee each association sponsored the convention in turn. They appointed a dancer chairman assisted by a vice chairman from the callers and one from the cuers. All of these were from within the association and must belong to their respective state organization. They basically had full control of their actions under the guidelines from the Coordinating Committee. The Coordinating Committee was composed of the immediate past chairman and vice chairmen, the current chairpersons and the chairpersons for the next three associations in line. Thus there were three people from each of the five associations on the committee.

In 2008 the Coordinating Committee was disbanded. The seed money was turned over to the Florida Federation of Square Dancers to administer. The seed money is still funded by the Florida Callers Association, the Round Dance Council of Florida and the Florida Federation of Square Dancers. The Guidelines are still maintained by the coordinated efforts of all three organizations and the conventions still use them in the planning of each convention.

Starting with the 2010 State Convention, the rotation of chairmen through the five associations ceased and the Convention Chairman is appointed by the President of the Florida Federation of Square Dancers from anywhere within the State of Florida. With this change, the State Convention became a true State Convention. The dancers that organize the convention each year come from all over the state. They are no longer limited to one association.

Some Interesting Facts About Square Dance History in Florida

Formal organization of the Florida Square Dance Federation was attempted at a breakfast meeting on November 10, 1957, in Jacksonville, according to Harry Moore of Miami, acting chairman. Moore, as president of the Southeastern Square Dancers Association, invited officers of similar groups to Central Florida.

The Florida West Coast and the Jacksonville area attended a pilot meeting in Winter Haven held in conjunction with the caller's association convention October 6. Out of the Winter Haven meeting came a resolution requesting the four regional groups to sanction the Federation idea and name two delegates to the organizational meeting in Jacksonville.

Formation of the Florida Federation of Square Dancers took a long step toward realization as temporary delegates for Florida's four regional Dancers' associations met in Jacksonville November 10, 1957 to approve a charter and select temporary officers. The charter was submitted to the four regional groups for ratification, after which the final and permanent Federation organization was to be established.

Harry Moore of Miami was elected temporary chairman and Wendell Kaiser of Tampa was elected temporary vice-chairman. Other officers included Al Cody, Kissimmee, temporary secretary and Tom Egleston, Jacksonville, temporary treasurer.

Formal organization of the Florida Federation of Square Dancers was the principal business at a meeting of the permanent board of delegates held in Melbourne on Sunday afternoon, January 12, 1958, announced by Harry Moore of Surfside, temporary President.

With ratification of the proposed charter by the Southeast Florida Square and Round Dancers' Association in Ft. Lauderdale on December 8, 1957 the State Federation had won acceptance by all of the state's four regional dancer's organizations.

The Northwest Association joined the Federation in 1975, bringing the total number of associations in the Federation to five, where it remains today.

Competition at the 59th NSDC!

The National Executive Committee has approved competition for both Youth and Adults at the 59th National Square Dance Convention®. We are going to model our competition after Long Beach's competition and use the "last square dancing" concept. There will be two sessions: Open Competition on Thursday afternoon, June 24th and Youth Competition on Friday afternoon, June 25th.

The Open Competition will be open to all dancers. It will be held in Freedom Hall on Thursday at 4:00 PM. In order to participate, you must sign up as part of a complete square and turn in your sign-up form at the Competition Registration Table in the East

Hall Main Lobby (by the 59th NSDC Registration tables) no later than 12:30 PM on Thursday. The Competition Registration Table will be open on Wednesday, June 23rd from 2:00 until 5:00 and again on Thursday, June 24th from 9:00 AM until 12:30 PM. You must sign up as a complete square. Individuals or couples may meet at the table and group themselves into squares. For complete rules and procedures and for sign-up forms, click the links below.

The Youth Competition will be open to all dancers age 18 and under. It will be held in the Variety Hall on Friday, June 25th at 4:15 PM. Sign ups will take place in the Youth Hall. You must sign up as part of a complete square. Youth Dancers can meet in the Youth Hall and form squares and then sign up.

These sessions are one time only events at the 59th NSDC and are just for fun. **ENJOY YOURSELF AND HAVE A GOOD TIME!**

Copied from the registration form:

...our Team/Square agrees:

- 1) We can only participate if we are wearing our 59th NSDC Badge and are wearing proper square dance attire for this Competition.
- **2)** All members of this team/square are fully capable of dancing all calls at Mainstream Level.
- **3)** We must be in constant movement and if we break down, we will be allowed one (1) time of ten (10) beats of music to fix our square from our Square Judge.
- **4)** We understand it is our responsibility to check that the Square Judge assigned to us is not from the same State as any of our team/square members or we will have to be disqualified.
- **5)** We agree to stop dancing and leave the floor if our Judge gives us the black flag, even if some members of our team/square do not agree with his/her ruling.
- **6)** We understand all the rules of the Competition and agree to have fun while participating in this event.
- **7)** Early Open Competition Registration is available for any team who already has a set square of eight (8) people; they may email their completed Registration form to Program@59thnsdc.com before Sunday, June 20, 2010.

All Team/Square Members must arrive no later than **3:30 PM on Thursday, June 24, 2010** in the Main Lobby of Freedom Hall for Check-in. All eight (8) Participants must be present to be assigned a Square Judge and numbers.
