Fall Fun Fest

We will again be having a themed basket silent auction at the next Fall Fun Fest. All clubs and dancers are invited to donate a themed basket to be included in the silent auction to raise funds for the 2011 Florida State Convention. You're welcome to donate more than one basket if you like. Be creative; make your basket with any theme you choose. Your club can donate a basket or if you want to donate one individually, you are welcome to do that too. If you're not familiar with how a silent auction works, a piece of paper is with each item. If you want to bid on something, you write your name on the list along with the amount you want to bid. Everyone has a chance to keep bidding all evening increasing the bid amount each time. The person with the highest bid at the end of the evening gets the basket.

When planning your theme, please keep the following in mind:

- 1) Minimum retail value of basket should be included. (If basket is worth more than \$50.00 retail, please split into two baskets).
- 2) Gift certificates should be good for 6 months.
- 3) Gift certificates should accommodate anyone within the West Coast Association area.
- 4) Gift certificates should not require purchase to receive the gift.
- 5) Bring or make arrangements to bring your basket(s) to the Fall Fun Fest on Friday November 13th, 2009, no later than 6:30pm.
- 6) Wrap the entire basket in shrink or cellophane wrap to ensure all the items stay with the basket.
- 7) Baskets should pertain to a selected theme and be aesthetically pleasing.
- 8) Theme basket items may be embellished or adjusted to suit your club's style and taste. Creative and exciting baskets yield a successful auction.

Some suggested themes:

- a. "Holiday Basket" choose any holiday for your theme.
- b. **"TLC Basket"** foot wash, "Calgon", candle, bath beads, manicure set, lotions.
- c. **"Picnic Basket"** picnic table set from \$1.00 store has great checkered tablecloths, Mosquito spray, outdoor fun games, Frisbee, ball.
- d. "Laundry Basket" bleach, powder (non scent), fabric softener, hangers, dryer towels.
- e. **"Family Fun Basket"** popcorn, soft drinks, candy bars, nuts, etc.
- f. **"Baking Basket"** put everything into a large plastic bowl, mini-muffin pan. All purpose flour, baking powder, baking soda, chocolate chips, etc. put in a couple of recipes.
- g. **"Baby Basket"** q-tips, bibs, wipes, receiving blankets, diapers, pacifier, etc. "maybe someone will make a quilt".
- h. **"FSU Basket"** (or any school), cups, books, shirts, key rings, tickets, etc.
- i. "Book Club Basket" bestsellers, book light, snacks, journals.
- i. **"Red Hat Society Basket"** red hat, shirt, socks, anything pertaining to the Red Hat theme.

These are themes that have been used in prior years; feel free to come up with new ones.

Many clubs ask their members to donate items or money to create the basket in the selected theme.

When you have chosen your theme, please notify Flo Byington what your theme(s) will be and how many baskets you will be donating; hopefully, this will eliminate duplication of themes.

This has always been a successful fundraiser for West Coast; let's do it again!
