#### From the Editor....



Do you know someone who goes above and beyond promoting and supporting square dancing in the West Coast Association? Now is the time to recognize and thank that couple or solo. July 20 is the deadline to submit your nominations for the *West Coast Association Distinguished Service Award.* This award will be presented at the Fall Fun Fest on Saturday night, November 12.

As a reminder, the guidelines are as follows:

PURPOSE: To recognize a member(s) of the West Coast Square and Round Dancers' Association (WCSRDA) who has given service to the WCSRDA above and beyond the average dancer.

COMMITTEE: The committee shall consist of the five most recent recipients of the award. Each year a new member will come on and the longest serving will resign (unless someone else has to resign). They will elect a chairman from within. A quorum, a simple majority, is required to transact any business. This committee will review all nominations and select a winner by vote of the majority attending the meeting. The recipient(s) will not be revealed until the presentation.

NOMINATIONS: Any WCSRDA member may make nominations. Nominations will be submitted in the form of a resume. The resume shall include, but not be limited to:

- 1. Number of years dancing
- 2. Number of years member of WCSRDA
- 3. Club membership
- 4. Offices held or holding at all levels. List the special contributions which you believe qualifies the nominee for the award.
- 5. Nominations shall be submitted no later than July 20.

PRESENTATION: The award will be presented annually at the Fall Fun Fest.

There are several people who work very hard to promote dancing in our area; surely there is someone you know who should be recognized with this award.

Please remember that this award is for dancers active at the West Coast level. If you have a dancer(s) in your club that you want to recognize, there is the Circle of Service award for that purpose.

The National Square Dance Convention in Detroit is now history; and from the reports I have been receiving, they had good attendance and Florida was well represented. I'm being told the total registration as of Friday night was 3,732 with 117 from Florida. The 2012 convention in Spokane already has 3,085 registrations with 53 from Florida; Oklahoma (2013) has 811 registrations with seven from Florida; and Little Rock (2014) has 585 registrations with nine from Florida. The 2015 convention was to be announced Saturday night but I haven't received information on that yet.

Congratulations to Jerry and Donna Robey, from the Northeast Association, on their election as directors of the USDA Central Region (which includes Florida). You may recall that I was writing about them a year or two ago as they were earning their traveler badges for dancing in all 50 states.

I was told that the hand over the heart is for the Pledge of Allegiance only, when the flag is present. Is that true, and what is the proper procedure? *St. Louis Patriot* 

**Dear Patriot:** No, it is not true. Whoever criticized you were ignorant of the Flag Code, as amended by the 94<sup>th</sup> Congress and approved July 7, 1976.

According to the code, "During the rendition of the national anthem when the flag is displayed, all present...shall stand at attention facing the flag with the right hand over the heart. When the flag is not displayed, those present should face toward the music and act in the manner they would if the flag were displayed there.
