We've made it!

Summary of our extraordinary experience with square dancing

The following article is a reprint (exactly) from USDA News Vol.ume XXII, Issue 3, July/September 2011 and was written by Oli and Andrea Kuester of Germany. When Jerry and Donna Robey of Gainesville were working on their Traveler Badges, they ran into Oli and Andrea while they were working on theirs. The Kuesters visited Strawberry Square last year while they were dancing in Florida.

When we graduated in Mainstream in August 2008, we had no idea that it will change our lives.

We started square dancing in October 2007 when some friends searched for a new hobby they could share. They asked us to go with them to an "Open House" of the Square company Dusseldorf because we like the USA and travel each year to the United States since 1992. We liked it and had fun but our friend didn't.

We started the class with 17 students and in December we met the first time in a private home to practice. We had CDs and a newer caller helped us and retaught the figures we had problems with. Next time when we met without a caller and the CD's were to fast to dance. Oli started calling. We found out that we love to dance, and founded a "Self regulating Community for Square Dance Addition: to dance as often as possible.

At the beginning Oli had no idea how to get us back home while calling, but he keeps us moving and could explain very well. On our graduation in August 2008, he performed his first singing call. The students could dance it because we had practiced it but the angels had their problems. That was fun.

After the graduation we started square dancing three to five times a week, visited many "Special Dances" and did some "banner raiding". Oli got the chance to do two singing calls every club evening.

When we planned our next vacation in the USA I searched for Square Dancing in the United States. I found many Web-Pages and also the USDA Travel Program with the goal to dance in all 50 sates of the USA. We thought that could be interesting for us because we travel so much.

We rote Joy an E-Mail and asked if we could join that program although we are no residents of the United States. She found no reason against it so we started to plan our first trip. We planned to dance in five or six different states and thought we could finish that program within ten years.

During our vacation in October 2008 we visited a zoo, three theme parks, made a segway tour in Indianapolis and had time to shop. We decided to visit some more states as planned and when the vacation was over we have danced in the following states:

- 2 times in Kansas
- 2 times in Missouri
- 1 time in Illinois
- 2 times in Indiana
- 1 time in Michigan
- 1 time in Ohio
- 1 time in West Virginia

1 time in Tennessee

- 2 times in Kentucky
- In Missouri we went to a dance with Mike Sikorsky and had no idea what will await us. It was amazing.

In Indiana we danced also at the State Convention were we met Linda and David Isom and inspired them to take part at the USDA travel program, too.

We enjoyed meeting very nice people and had a lot of fun.

In an one hour drive from our home we have almost 50 clubs we could visit.

Less then tree months after our graduation we already danced in 26 different clubs.

In most of the German square dance clubs they have the rule to dance one or two years mainstream before you learn PLUS. We danced so much that we had a lot of experience and started our PLUS class in January (4 month after our graduation).

In March 2009 we flew to *Hawaii*, visited two islands and danced in Pearl City and Honolulu on Oahu. We liked the beautiful nature.

From Hawaii we flew to Las Vegas. From there we started a round trip by car with stops in several states just for square dancing.

Very special was the part where we drove from Colorado to Wyoming. On the way we had a snowstorm and black ice. The view was very bad. We arrived in the city but the caller couldn't make the way. The next morning the weather wasn't good but we could leave the town and drove to Utah were we danced to Steve Sullivan. We spend the next day together with him and his wife Judy and had a great time. Oli go some tips about calling from Steve and in the evening at Steve's club in Idaho Oli made his first singing call in the USA.

In California we visited relatives so we stayed there for a week. After this vacation we have danced in 16 states:

-	1 time in Arizona	-	1 time in Colorado
-	1 time in Utah	-	1 time in Idaho

- 1 time in Nevada - 5 times in California

In April we graduated in PLUS and were founding members of a new PLUS club.

The president had heard that Oli had started calling so from Mai 2008 he got support from the club caller and could use the dance hall one hour prior the regular club dance. He always had one or two squares for practice and learned a lot.

Oli's caller father (Markus Lampenscherf) had heard from a club that was looking for a new club caller for the next year. Markus had heard Oli just once calling then he warmly recommended Oli to the board of that club. The board came to hear him and was interested.

Amazing! In our club in Dusseldorf he didn't get so much support.

In June Oli had a business trip to Pittsburgh in Pennsylvania and I had to stay at home. Olie went dancing five times.

After that trip Oli signed his first caller contract for the club in Bergisch Gladbach starting at the end of the year.

In October 2009 we flew again to America for vacation. We travelled around, visited two theme parks, hopped on our trip and had a ball while dancing.

We danced:

- 2 times in Maryland
- 1 time in Virginia
- 1 time Delaware
- 1 time in Pennsylvania
- 1 time in Vermont
- 2 times in Massachusetts
- 1 time in Connecticut
- 1 time in Canada

- 1 time in North Carolina
- 1 time in Washington D.C.
- 1 time in New Jersey
- 1 time in New York
- 2 times in New Hampshire
- 1 time in Rhode Island
- 2 times in Maine
- -

In Delaware we met the first time another couple (Jerry and Donna Robey) that took part at the USDA Travel Program. We talked a lot about the experience of our travels and became friends. We checked our schedules and found out that we will meet again two more times on that trip. That was very funny but also nice to meet friends again.

In Main we take part at a Kick Off Dance for the New England Convention were we met also some of the dancers we have met before.

On the internet I found the Northeastern Caller School from Ken Ritucci in Manchester. Only one and a half day fits in our schedule before we have to fly home but Oli could join and we met caller like Ed Foote, Norm Poissons, Jerry Story and Barry Clasper.

Also we met some callers and dancers we have already danced with on that trip. At this caller school Oli could find out how much he had already learned with the support from Markus. It was sad that he couldn't stay the full time but we decided to come back the next year.

In November we went to a Caller School from Kenny Reese in Germany. It was different to the one in America but also very helpful. The classes were built by the years of experience so Oli started at the beginner class but after one day he switched to the intermediate class. Kenny Reese was surprised about his voice and his knowledge because he hadn't heard his name before but I'm sure now he will remember.

Short before Christmas Oli become the club caller of the "Flat Creek Roses". In Germany it is hard to become a club caller, so caller wait for many years to get a chance but he was at the right time at the right place. He had really luck!

Also at the end of the yea he took over from Markus a bi weekly calling for another club. Wow, that was fantastic, too.

At that two clubs he could use all his knowledge and could practice a lot. The dancers understood that it could happen that he makes mistakes but he became berry every week. He was enthusiastic and you could feel and see how much fun he had while calling. The dancers loved him.

In January 2010 we started to join an A1 class. The club where we dance on Sundays offered that. For us it was much harder to learn A1 then to learn PLUS.

Our next vacation in the USA was in April 2010.

We danced:

- 1 time in Alaska
- 1 time in Wisconsin
- 1 time in South Dakota
- 1 time in North Dakota
- 1 time in Wyoming
- 2 times in Oregon

- 1 time in Iowa
- 1 time in Minnesota
- 1 time in Nebraska
- 1 time in Montana
- 1 time in Utah
- 1 time in Washington

In Alaska we stayed a few days, had a lot of fun at a Pie Auction and visited a wildlife refuge.

In Minnesota we take part at a "Royalty Dance" and in Nebraska we visited a "Spring Spectacular".

When we arrived in North Dakota we found out that the dance for the next day in Wyoming was canceled, because the caller has moved. It was the only club that hasn't answered on our e-mail but they had that dance in their schedule on the internet. If we had this information earlier, we could dance in Wyoming in the morning on our way to North Dakota.

We tried to call different clubs and callers but had no luck. The next morning we veer towards Montana because we hoped to get a call for advance in Montana for that day. At noon we stopped at a McDonald's because we had no bars on our cell phone and checked our e-mails. Once again no luck, the caller couldn't help us. We had a phone number for a class in Montana. We called there and they offered us to come. We checked the navigation and we were to late to arrive in time but we decided to try it and we arrived while the class was still on going.

In Wyoming we danced a day later at the club where the dance was cancelled one year before. From Wyoming we drove to Idaho and visited again Steve and Judy Sullivan and Oli called a club dance together with Steve in Utah.

In Oregon we visited our family, went to a dance with Mike Sikorsky and drove to an anniversary dance in Washington. Then the vacation was over.

When we were back home, Oli became the new club caller of the Square company Dusseldorf, the club where we have learned to dance. The old caller was in this club for 15 years but the members like Oli's enthusiasm and fun while calling. Some people that about leaving the club because of the old caller, so it was a good decision of the board to change something.

Oli is calling now 3 to 4 times a week on a regular basis. Unbelievable after that short time of practice. I like to hear him calling, so most of the time I accompany him when he falls and I dance.

I spend a lot time while planning our trips. When we know which states we want to visit I search for the days of dances and check with a map in which sequence we could visit them and how far are the distances between the clubs. Then I search for e-mail addresses to get in contact with the clubs and when they have answered we check for hotels on our way.

This way I did to plan our last trip and to finish the 50 states. On our trip in October 2010-12-18 we danced:

- 2 times in Texas
- 1 time in Oklahoma
- 1 time in Arkansas
- 1 time in Alabama
- 1 time in Georgia
- 9 times in Florida

- 1 time in New Mexico
- 1 time in Louisiana
- 1 time in New Hampshire
- 1 time in Mississippi
- 1 time in South Carolina

In Texas we went again to a special dance with Mike Sikorsky and Nasser Shukayr.

In New Hampshire we visited again the caller school of Ken Ritucci in Manchester. At the caller school were great caller coaches like Ann Ueberlacker, Tim Marriner, Barry Clasper.... We me some caller from the year before and also some new caller. The caller school is a lot of work but also fun. This year we received the Overseas Award of the Northeastern Caller School. What an honor!

After the caller school we flew to Pensacola and started to dance in the last 5 states. In Florida we had the chance to dance at a special with Tim Marriner. That was really funny. We also met some callers and dancers from the rest of our trip. Our 50th state we danced with the "Travelling Hoedowners" and Jerry and Donna Robey at the "Whirl and Twirls" in Orlando and also celebrated that at Jerry's and Donnas Club, the "Grand Squares" in Gainesville.

Now we are reached our goal not in ten years we only need two years and eleven days. We met a lot of people, we never would met without square dancing. E found some really good friends and we become an idea what it means "Square dancing is friendship set to music!"
