United Squares Dancers of America (USDA) Square Dance Insurance

Square dance insurance is available to us through the USDA. This insurance provides individuals with secondary health insurance and provides the clubs with liability insurance. The secondary insurance covers you at dances, demos, banner raids and retrievals, conventions and festivals; any activity that includes square dancing. The liability insurance provides coverage to clubs for any damage that happens to the facility where you hold your dances. Many clubs elect not to participate in this insurance program because they live in a community that already has liability insurance; however, your community liability insurance will not cover the dancer when traveling to other halls, doing demos in the community, and participating in banner raids and retrievals.

The cost is so minimal you shouldn't pass it up. For just \$4.45 per dancer, you will have \$1,000,000 combined single limit of liability for bodily injury and property damage each occurrence (subject to \$100 property damage deductible per claim) while participating in scheduled and sponsored dancing activities. \$100,000 limit on damage to premises rented to you. There is a limit or "aggregate" of \$1,000,000 for all product liability claims combined. This includes products liability for food or beverages served at a dance (e.g., when a person claims that, after eating food, he or she became ill and needed medical attention which resulted in medical expense).

Insurance is issued to cover the time period of January 1 – December 31. For those clubs who are already participating, the renewals will become due soon. In order to have continuous coverage, you should plan to send in your renewals in November. Due to the volume of renewals at the end of the year, the earlier you submit your renewals the better. Even if all of your members haven't renewed their membership, you should send in your premiums as soon as you have eight people on your roster. As the rest of your members renew their membership, you can send in additional lists to have them covered.
