From the Editor...



This Friday, December 21st, will be a sad day in the Tampa Bay area. Spinning Wheels will be holding their final dance after a long history of dancing in Tampa (40+ years). This club was started by Art and Martha Springer and I am sure this is an especially sad time for them.

When I started dancing, Spinning Wheels was at the North Boulevard location. The hall was always packed and sometimes they had to set up speakers in a second hall so they could accommodate all the dancers. They also had so many kids dancing with them that they formed a club

for them called the Spin Offs.

You could always count on a huge crowd from Spinning Wheels for the state convention, Fall Fun Fest, and banner raids. As with all the other clubs, over time their membership has dwindled due to death and illness. A small nucleus of people has been trying to keep the club going the past few years but after so many years they are tired of all the work and there aren't any new dancers to take over. It is my sincere wish that these remaining dancers will join other clubs and continue dancing.

This brings to my mind the question of what are you doing to support the local clubs. Many dancers don't join a club because they don't want to do all the work. Well, if more people would join and help with the work, there wouldn't be so much work for a few individuals. Dances don't just happen. At some dances tables and chairs need to be set up and taken down, people want refreshments and beverages, there's advertising to do, classes to angel at, banner raids and retrievals, and callers and cuers have to be scheduled.

The best way to get new dancers is to sponsor a class, and if your club members aren't at the classes helping out and getting to know these new people, they will have no interest at all in joining your club. You do not have to be a member of the sponsoring club to be at these classes to angel. Do you remember when you first started and the people who helped you learn? Even if you show up at a class to angel and you aren't needed in a square, you can visit with the new dancers and get to know them and their interests. Being a friendly club doesn't end at the door to the dance. It has to continue throughout the dance and into the classes.

Polk Senior Games

For several years square dancing has been an event at the Polk Senior Games in Polk County. This is one of many ways to draw attention to our fun and friendly "sport".

How does square dancing qualify as a sport? When we hear the word sport, we instantly think about running, tennis, bowling, shuffleboard, biking, etc. I looked up the word sport and according to Merriam-Webster the definition is to amuse oneself; a source of diversion: RECREATION; physical activity engaged in for pleasure. Does that sound like dancing? There is even ballroom and social dancing at the Senior Games. I believe Polk County is the only Florida county that includes square dancing as an event.

The Senior Games is a two-week series (Saturday February 23 – Monday, March 11, 2013) of Olympic-style competition for men and women 50 and over. Most events are grouped by gender in five-year age increments. Gold, Silver, and Bronze medals are presented in each event and age division. **Polk County residency is not required**.

Registration begins the first week of January. Entries must be postmarked by Wednesday, February 6 or hand delivered to the Polk Senior Games office by Friday, February 8. Registration booklets are mailed by request. There is no late or on-site registration. **Square dancers must register as a square.**

The entry fee is \$10 per person for the first event and \$3 for each additional event up to a maximum of \$28. Everyone receives a PSG T-shirt designed by artist Chryssie Tavrides.

Polk Senior Games was founded in 1992 by Nancye Thornberry of Lakeland who was inspired by her 70-year-old brother competing at the National Senior Games in Syracuse, NY. With the support of the Polk County community, the Games began in 1992 with 777 entrants. The Games have grown to be the largest of the 20 local senior games in Florida with over 2,500 participants in 2012. PSG is a non-profit, 501(c)3, organization managed by a salaried Executive Director and a volunteer Board of Directors and presented in cooperation with the Parks and Recreation Departments in Polk County and over 600 volunteers.

The square dance event will be Monday, February 25, 2013 at 1:30 p.m. at the Lake Ashton Clubhouse in Lake Wales. There will be a practice session from 1:00 - 1:30 p.m. Immediately following the event, there will be a free square dance for all square dancers.

Even if you don't participate in the "sporting" event, please come support the participants and enjoy the free dance afterwards.
