

### 61st National Square Dance Convention

#### UPDATE ON 61<sup>ST</sup> TOURS

If you are considering the Glacier Park Tour, there are still a few seats left on the bus taking you there. You do not have to be concerned that it will cancel at the last minute, as it is well over the minimum number for the trip to "go ahead".

Our most popular tour, the Grand Coulee Dam Geologic Tour is filling up quickly. It is just a few seats away from the maximum number it can handle.

For the Spokane City Tour, the Friday or Saturday tours will be a little less crowded and allow for better sightseeing at the Flower Filled Conservatory and the St. John's Cathedral!

The Thursday four-hour cruise on Lake Coeur d'Alene, with a fabulous lunch spread, promises to be a highlight for all of you taking a break after the Wednesday Night Special Event, "The Time Benders", or the Trail-End Dances put on by national callers on Wednesday evening.

### The Washington State Tour has been cancelled, as has the Buck Knife, Cabela's & Lunch Tour on Friday.

#### Washington State Fruit-the Apple



The apple was chosen as a symbol for the 61<sup>st</sup> NSDC<sup>®</sup> for a reason. Washington designated the apple as the official state fruit in 1989. The Washington apple is one of the most recognized symbols of the state worldwide. Washington produces about 42% of the apples grown in the United States, with 60% of those grown for fresh consumption. Apple acreage in Washington is estimated at about 200,000 acres. The majority of apple production occurs east of the Cascade Mountains in the central portion of the state. Go west of Spokane to Wenatchee and south to the Yakima Valley and you are in the heart of the apple growing area of the state.

During 2007-2009, production averaged annually about 130,000,000 "bushels," with an average of 100,000,000 bushels packed in boxes and sold fresh, and 30,000,000 bushels processed. (Bushel = about 44 lbs or 20Kg.) The value of Washington apples sold as fresh or processed product is estimated at about \$2.2 billion annually. Not only does this industry provide food,

but it is also a large employer in all facets of the production of apples. Additionally, the apple juice producer, Tree Top, Inc. is located in Washington State in the town of Selah.

The cost of production of an acre of apples is about \$5,200 to \$7,400, depending on a number of common orchard variables. The greatest expense is the labor for picking, pruning and hand fruit thinning. Packing and marketing adds an additional \$5,600 to \$7,500 of cost per average acre of production, about half of which is labor related.

From 28 to 32 percent of the crop is exported annually, with major markets in the Asian Pacific Rim, Canada, Mexico, and South America.

Many varieties of apple are grown in Washington State, including Red Delicious, Golden Delicious, Fuji, Gala, Granny Smith, Braeburn, Jonagold, Pink Lady, and Cameo. About 100 packinghouses store, sort, box and ship Washington apples, nearly all twelve months of the year.

#### Nothing beats the taste of a cold, crisp apple, grown in Washington State!

#### TRANSPORTATION AT THE 61<sup>st</sup> NSDC IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Due to economic budgetary cutbacks by the Spokane Transit System (STA), significant changes are required to the Transportation Services being offered for the attendees of the 61<sup>st</sup> NSDC. After careful review of the STA schedule and routing abilities, it has been determined that extensive use of the STA provided services is not conducive to the success of transporting our Convention attendees. All shuttle and bus transportation is now sponsored by the 61<sup>st</sup> National Square Dance Convention<sup>®</sup>. The 'STA' bus pass, which has previously been offered on the Registration Form, is being automatically converted to the 61<sup>st</sup> NSDC Parking Lot Shuttle pass. If you do not have your own transportation to get to the Parking lot, those of you staying at one of the Convention Hotels should consider the Hotel/Motel bus pass.

#### Parking Lot Shuttle:

A parking lot will be available at 801 N. Cincinnati Street in the Gonzaga University District. You can either walk the .8 mile lighted path, or ride the 10-minute shuttle, to the Convention Center. It is STRONGLY recommended that you purchase the "Parking Lot Shuttle Pass" on the Registration Form for only \$12 per person.

#### **RV Shuttle:**

For all those folks that are planning to bring their RV's to the beautiful Pacific Northwest, and attend the National Convention, there will be an 'RV Bus Pass' available for purchase (\$40 per person) for the folks using the RV facilities at the Spokane Exposition Center (404 N. Havana St., Spokane Valley, WA 99202). These bus passes will only be available for the 'RV' registered guests.

#### Hotel/Motel Shuttle:

For those hotels not listed as 'walking' hotels on the Registration Form that are located to the east and west of the downtown core, the 61st NSDC will provide busses. The hotel/motel bus pass is available for purchase (\$40 per person) by attendees staying at these hotels.

#### 61<sup>st</sup> NSDC LIMITED PARKING

The Convention Center is located in Downtown Spokane and parking is very limited. It is STRONGLY recommended that you purchase the "Parking Lot Shuttle Pass" on the Registration Form for only \$12 per person. A parking lot will be available at 801 N. Cincinnati Street in the Gonzaga University District. You can either walk the .8 mile lighted path, or ride the 10-minute shuttle to the Convention Center. Again, it is suggested that you pre-purchase the \$12 per person "Parking Lot Shuttle Pass" for day-to-day transportation to the Convention Center.
