From the Editor....

Many thanks to Bill and Marge Webb for making the arrangements to use the clubhouse at Sun & Fun RV Park. And many thanks to the people who brought finger foods for the refreshment table; it was delicious.

There are more clubs closing this week! For those who dance with a seasonal club that live in Florida year round, please remember that there are several clubs who dance through the summer. They are Palace Promenaders in Arcadia; Shufflin' Squares at Lake Ashton in Lake Wales; Bay Area Twirlers (BATS) in Brandon; Spinning Wheels in Tampa; Temple Twirlers in Tampa; Suncoast Squares in St. Petersburg; Promenade Squares in Pinellas Park; and Orange Blossom Squares in The Villages. These are the only clubs that I know for sure are dancing through the summer. There may be others that I have not received information on. Just check the DANCERgram every week to find a dance you would be interested in. The clubs that dance through the summer have a drastic drop in attendance when the snowbirds leave; please try to support as many of them as possible.

There are many new dancers on the floor now as classes hold their graduations. Please welcome them in to your squares and answer any questions they may have. If you don't know the answer, check with your club president, West Coast county rep, or I would be happy to assist you.

New Dancers, just a few things to help you enjoy your dancing experience. Many of the clubs alternate Mainstream and Plus Squares. Strawberry Square is one place where levels are not mixed at a dance. Wednesday night is a Mainstream/Easy Plus dance; Saturday night is straight Plus. If you have not completed a Plus workshop, please do not attempt to dance the Plus level. If you don't know for sure what the level is at a dance, just check the DANCERgram.

Regarding proper attire; some clubs are casual for the entire year. This doesn't mean you can't wear square dance attire if you like. Some clubs are only casual during the summer months. Strawberry Square prefers square dance attire for their evening dances, but allow casual during the day. The State Convention, association festivals, and the Winter Festival all ask for proper square dance attire for their evening sessions, but accept casual for the daytime sessions. If you're not sure what the attire is for a dance, you might want to call ahead and find out. I don't think you will want to stand out because you are dressed differently than everyone else.

What is accepted square dance attire? In addition to the traditional square dance dress or skirt with a crinoline, square dance skirts without crinolines and prairie skirts are considered square

dance attire. Men are asked to wear long sleeved shirts. Women who dance the left position (or the man's position) exclusively, will sometimes wear slacks so it is easier for everyone to recognize that they are dancing that position. Of course, don't forget to wear your badge!

The Florida State Convention is fast approaching. Have you purchased your ribbons yet? Advance ribbons are \$35 per person for the entire weekend. If you only want to attend part of the convention, there are split prices which you can take care of at the convention. Those of us selling ribbons can only sell for the entire weekend. There will be a Trail-In Dance at Strawberry Square on Thursday night, May 24th with Charlie Pergrossi and Ted Kennedy calling and Lisa Wall cueing. The convention itself is from May 25 – 27 at the Lakeland Center in Lakeland.
