From the Editor....



The Sixth Annual Party Weekend was held this past Friday and Saturday at the Deerhaven Conference Center in Paisley, Florida. The only representative from the West Coast Association was Jenny Green. This was the Central Association's fundraiser for the 2013 convention. Jenny brought back pictures.









As you can see, the theme for 2013 is the beach!! *Life is a Beach in 2013* is the official theme and beach attire (*no swim suits, tank tops, or short shorts please*) will be the dress on Friday night of the convention.

The convention is getting very close – Memorial Day Weekend May 25 – 27; have you made your plans yet and purchased your advance tickets? The host hotel is the Lakeland Hotel & Conference Center (formerly Holiday Inn North), 3260 U.S. Hwy. 98 North, Lakeland. You can make your reservations by calling 863-688-8080. Be sure to ask for the square dance rate of \$65 + tax. This rate includes two free breakfasts each morning. If they are full, there are many other hotels in the area – Comfort Inn, Country Inn & Suites, Hampton Inn, La Quinta Inn & Suites, Quality Inn & Suites, Royalty Inn, Stay Inn & Suites, and The Avenue Hotel. For the campers, there is a special rate for you at the Lakeland RV Resort. There is dry camping available at the Lakeland Center for around \$30 per night.

You'll want to purchase your ribbons in advance; not only because they're cheaper (\$35 per person for the entire weekend), but you won't have to stand in those long lines at the Lakeland Center! I still have ribbons and will always have them with me at the dances I attend. The advance price is good until May 24, 2012, which is the night of the Trail-In Dance at Strawberry Square. The cost of the Trail-In Dance is separate from the cost of the convention itself and is a donation. Charlie Pergrossi and Ted Kennedy will be calling. Lisa Wall will be cueing. This dance and the convention will be the last time Lisa will be cueing for us as a resident of Florida. She will be moving to Arizona in early June. We will sure miss her and hope she will be back to cue for us once in a while.

SINGLES/SOLOS or anyone needing a partner: There will be a singles hall on Friday night in Sikes F. Squares and rounds are programmed for the evening. Please come join us and get to know the other singles who will be dancing there at the convention. There will also be well-marked singles sections in each of the halls. If you don't have a partner and want to dance, please sit in these marked areas so everyone knows you are available to dance.

Now, on to another subject! I have to get up on my soap box once in a while and it's been quite a while since I've been on the box. The subject this time is joining a square without a partner. This isn't acceptable and is frowned upon by many of the other dancers. If a single joins a square alone and no one ever comes to join you, you have prevented three other couples from forming a complete square. Many times a single in a square alone means that a couple has to split up with one of them having to go sit down. It's hard to believe, but there are couples who do not like their partner dancing with someone else. You should enter a square with a partner or know for sure that one is on the way.

I think just about all of the seasonal clubs are closed for the season now. If you belong to a seasonal club, why not take advantage of the down time and branch out to visit the year round clubs? You can check their schedules in the "What's Happening This Week?" section below.

Square Dance Tips

Square Dance Tips

Keep your square tight.

When you form your square, keep it as tight as possible so that the dancers don't have to take as many steps and everyone will be able to keep up with the caller. When promenading, dancers in the left hand position (boys) keep your left shoulder close to the center of the square so you can return home in time for the next call.

Always know who your partner is and what your position is.

This can be done by touching hands. You should always be holding your partner's (the person beside you) hand. Your partner will not always be the person you started dancing with. When you are in a line or a wave, always touch hands with the people beside you so you are ready for whatever the caller calls next. A hand hold or forearm hold should always be a light touch; not a death grip. In some parts of the country and internationally, the hand hold is palms up.

Hand Hold vs Forearm Hold

When doing a left allemande, each person lightly places their left forearm against the other person's forearm. Do not wrap your hand around the arm (clutch). Do not cup your hand around the elbow. When standing next to your partner, always hold his/her hand; man's hand up, lady's hand placed on top. The hand hold should always be a gentle light touch; no

squeezing or hard pressure. Many dancers have arthritis and it is very painful if you squeeze their hands too tightly.

When standing in a wave, always take the hand of the person next to you. If you have someone on both sides of you, take the hand of both people.

When completing a Flutter Wheel, the two facing ladies move to the center. When they are right shoulder to right shoulder, they touch right forearms and with the left hand take the man from across the square and bring him back to the home position letting go of the other woman's forearm and face each other.

When circulating, always tap hands with the person you come up next to before circulating to the next position. This will tell you your positioning.

When completing a Grand Square, always take the hand of the person next to you, so you know who your partner is at any given time.

Forming Your Square

Form your squares quickly. As soon as the round dancers have completed their rounds, squares should start forming.

Don't enter a square without having a partner lined up. Attempt to dance with different people each tip. It is discourteous to dance with the same people all the time and makes you appear to be a snob.

Always fill the empty spot in the first square you come to. Don't walk by a square that has an empty spot.

If your square needs dancers, hold up the number of fingers for the number of couples you need so that the caller can announce what is needed. If all the other squares are filled and you still need dancers, start a simultaneous clap routine until dancers fill the vacancies. This is a universal notification of square openings. Dancers who are sitting out should immediately rise and fill the openings when they hear this clapping.

By quickly forming your squares, you will be able to start dancing as soon as the caller starts the music, and you will be probably be able to dance more during the evening because you aren't wasting time putting a square together.

Courtesy

Courtesy is something we should have learned as a child and carry it throughout our lives – please, thank you, your welcome, etc.

When you enter a square, say hello to everyone and introduce yourself.

Once you have joined a square, don't leave it to join another square.

At the end of the tip, clap to thank the caller, and then join hands with everyone in the square, bow down and say "thank you". Then shake hands with everyone individually and say thank you. This includes the women. So many times I have seen women just turn and walk away from the square like it's just the men's responsibility to thank everyone; not so, it's everyone's responsibility.

After each round, clap to say thank you to the cuer.

At the end of the evening, everyone forms a horseshoe – NOT A CIRCLE – facing the stage (or front of the room) – bow down and back up saying "thank you". Forming a horseshoe instead of a circle allows you to include the caller and cuer who are on the stage. If you form a circle, you exclude them.

Twirling

Some women do not want to be twirled; and if they don't want to be, they will either tell you verbally or will wear a badge stating this or when they come to you in the circle, her hand will be down indicating they do not want you to swing them.

Men: When you do twirl a woman, be gentle. You do not have to do anything other than hold your hand up for her to use to balance herself while twirling her; you can cause back, arm and shoulder injuries if this is doesn't correctly. One twirl is all that is needed.

Repair the Square

You're dancing and your square missed a call and you can't catch up; what do you do? Grab a partner; anyone; it doesn't have to be the partner you started dancing with. Form a square and bend the line. Remain in lines until the caller calls "lines". The caller will see you standing in lines and will bring all the dancers to lines so that everyone will be together. It doesn't matter which position you are in or who your partner is; as long as your square is dancing.

End of the Evening

Hopefully you have stayed until the end of the evening! Leaving the dance before the end of the evening gives the caller, cuer and the hosts the impression that they have not met your expectations of having a fun dance. The caller and cuer have spent several hours preparing the program for the dance, and sometimes have driven quite a distance to get there; then to have dancers walk out early is not very courteous. Attending a dance is like visiting a friend's house; after the visit, hopefully, the host(s) is thanked for a wonderful visit, a nice time and the delicious refreshments (if provided).

After the very last tip, everyone should form a horseshoe with the opening at the stage end of the hall (if the caller and cuer are still on the stage) or a circle (if the caller and cuer join the dancers on the floor); then everyone says "thank you" together.

Tips for an Effective Flyer

I have been asked to run this article again and I am happy to oblige. The comment was also made to me that many clubs do not indicate who their banner chairman is on their flyers, their websites, or in their listing in the West Coast Dancer. This lack of information sometimes means more telephone calls than necessary when a club plans a raid and is attempting to notify the club being visited.

Tips for an Effective Flyer

Do you have effective flyers for your dances and/or classes or are they just getting lost on the flyer table? Following are some tips:

Proofread

- Is everything spelled correctly?
- Is punctuation correct? Apostrophe s ('s) i.e. Susan's is possessive as in Susan owns something. If there is more than one girl named Susan, it is Susans. More and more I see the improper use of 's.
- Cuer is spelled with a "C", not a "Q".
- Are the phone numbers correct? Did you include the area code?
- Did you include the full address, including city and state? You never know
- when your flyers will be picked up and taken to another dance.

 Do you have the full date (with year) and the time?

 Did you include a contact name with working phone number (with area code) and working email address? I recommend that you use an email address that is checked frequently.
- Did you include the level of the dance?
- On your new beginner class flyers, are you using terminology that they will understand?

Appearance

- Does it look professional?
- If you taped or glued clip art on the flyer, can you see the outline when you make copies?
- Is the flyer typed? This looks more professional. Taking a typed flyer and then handwriting changes on it looks very tacky.
- Use colored paper when you make copies; this will make your flyer stand out
- Ensure you make clean copies and don't have a dirty background or a lot of
- marks on your copy.

 If you're able to obtain pictures of the caller and cuer, this helps the dancers

Hope these tips help!

One other quick thought; when you are laying flyers out on your table, take a quick look at them and throw out the "expired ones"
