The good thing is that while he is hospitalized they have called in an orthopedic doctor to study the MRI of the spine to see what can be done for the constant sciatic pain. The one thing that has been ruled out is a stroke; and the MRI, when compared to the MRI of the brain in 2010, shows little change (which means the progression of cells dying is not as fast). We know prayers help and would appreciate any offered for his relief of pain and a solution to what caused this latest event. # *Square Dance History Project (SDHP)*

## *Web Site*

In 2011 The ARTS received a request for financial support for a Square Dance History project. This project's major product is a web site with historical information. The web site includes a substantial collection of videos. The project group has also identified the location of other materials that can be made available with payment; this payment can be a fee to the owner of the footage and/or laboratory costs involved in making a digital copy from 16mm or 35mm film. The web address SquareDanceHistory.org has been activated with a description of the project, identification of the principal participants and the currently committed financial supporters.

On September 16, 2011, The ARTS approved a grant of \$2,500.00 to help fund a Square Dance History Project.

In June 2012 we received the following update from David Millstone, SDHP coordinator,

Last November's Dare To Be Square weekend brought six top-notch callers representing many different styles and regions. We posted 100 video clips of the dances, in two locations:

VidCaster <http://squaredancehistory.vidcaster.com/>

More recently, we uploaded 25 video clips of edited interviews with the six callers who were on staff: <http://squaredancehistory.org/omeka/exhibits/show/brasstown-interviews>

This link will take you to the prototype of our new Square Dance History Project's website. The home page for the exhibit provides links to each caller, and that subsequent page will offer two tabs, one for the caller's bio and one that takes you to a page listing those interviews, with a summary of the contents. Click on the photograph or underlined link to the right of each summary to bring up the video clip itself. In all, there are about two hours of interview footage available for viewing. Funding for the videography came from Country Dance and Song Society.

Even more recently, we've uploaded a dozen clips of traditional West Virginia caller Bill Ohse. These can be found on a new YouTube channel: <http://www.youtube.com/user/SquareDanceHistory2/videos?query=Ohse>

Additional videos on that channel range include MWSD, French-Canadian squares singing squares, New England squares, southern Appalachian four-couple squares, Kentucky set running, big sets, Ozark squares with jiggling, some demonstration pieces, and a CALLERLAB talk by Herb Egender on his experiences as a member of Pappy Shaw's Cheyenne Mountain Dancers.

We are in the process of importing video footage from the many different YouTube channels into our SD History Project collection, where it can be catalogued and organized for easy searches.

I'll keep you informed. Thanks again for your support of this project.
