Theme Dances Are FUN-tastic!

If you really love square dancing, the handicapable square dancers REALLY, REALLY love it. If your club dancers enjoy theme dances, the handicapable dancers REALLY, REALLY, REALLY, REALLY, REALLY, enjoy it.

This past year, our club had a monthly theme dance. We set them up so that one month was a "BIG" party and the next would be a "smaller" party. The difference was the BIG parties had refreshments, decorations and costumes, while the smaller themed dances were basically singing call selections.

We played lots of games and handed out fun dangles. Most of our dancers are Special Olympics participants and enjoy competing for badges, and they love the fun badges. Here's my list of dances with a few ideas to spice it up.

August: 1950's Sock Hop (hula hoop contest, bubble gum blowing contest, root beer floats) Big party

September: Disney Dance (Wear Disney apparel, played Fantasia on the DVD and lots of Disney singing calls) Small party

October: Hobo Dance (My singing call selection was all train songs). We made lots of hobo meals we found online. Anything from wrapping potatoes in aluminum foil to baked beans in the pot. Big Party.

November: Patriotic Dance in honor of Vets Day (We all dressed in Red, White and Blue and I called many patriotic songs) FYI We opened with the National Anthem and the Pledge and ended with singing God Bless America. Small party.

December: Christmas in the Caribbean (if it's cold outside, think hot) The dancers wore red and green while some sported hula skirts and straw hats. I played beach songs and Christmas carols for my singing calls. BIG PARTY.

January: Elvis Night (in honor of the King's birthday, several of us dressed up like Elvis and lip synced some of his songs) Singing call selection was a piece of cake since I have about 20 Elvis Presley singers. Small party.

February: Valentines Dance (Dressed in red and served red foods, drinks and sweets. Sang all LOVE song singing calls) Big Dance

March: St. Patrick's Dance (Donned our greens and served green refreshments. Lots of Irish Ditty singing calls, and I prompted a couple jigs and reels for some variety. Big Dance

April: Gospel Night (Singing call selection were all hymns, and there are so many great ones out there) Dancers all sang at the top of their lungs. Small party

May: Mexican Theme (Cinco de Mayo May 5th). Lots of Sombreros, decorations, and we even square danced the Limbo and Mexican Hat dance – served lots of chips and salsa. Great Mexican flair singing calls out there. BIG fiesta

June: Broadway Showtunes (Some dressed up as characters from their favorite musicals; one was dressed in Square Wear in honor of Oklahoma, poodle skirts and leather jackets for Grease and even a Technicolor Dream Coat) Singing call selection was great as we played "Name That Show Tune". Small party.

July: Christmas in July (if it's hot out, think cold) Served Christmas cookies, Red & Green Hawaiian Punch, and called all Christmas Carols that night. Lots of Santa, Elves and Reindeer hats with Hawaiian flower shirts. Big Party

August: Parrothead Party/Jimmy Buffett theme (Since I am a Buffett fan, I thought we'd end our full year of themes with one of my very favorites. There are a dozen or more Jimmy Buffett songs that were made into singing calls.) Left over parrot head hats to pass around. It was our annual picnic, so we had it under the pavilion and I hired an acoustic guitarist to play some Jimmy Buffett ballads for us while we ate. Big party

Take these ideas and go to town! Some have had these types of theme dances before, while others have different ones. Some extra ideas; at the Valentines Dance, I taught a very basic round dance. For the Christmas themed parties, I had the gang gather around the piano and

we sang Christmas carols. Yes, I had songbooks for everyone. We learned some Spanish words for the Mexican themed dance. I've had an Oktoberfest theme in the past before and I was able to locate a [group of] German Dancers who came in to perform for our group. I work in the activities department at a nursing home, so I have some creative ideas and avenues I like to travel down a lot.

When it comes to themes, if the caller gets into it, I believe the dancers will follow his lead. It might take awhile to motivate the dancers, families, staff and volunteers. Just remember, HAVE FUN! What Does Graduation Mean

A common statement for years has been: "Anyone can learn to square dance." Is this statement true? No!

My observation is that about 3% of all those who try square dancing cannot make it. This is not because of any physical impairment. It is just that mentally they cannot combine the call name with putting their body in the correct place.

What do we do with this 3%? We graduate them. What does "graduation" mean? Graduation in any activity means one has achieved a minimum level of skill required to perform the activity. So, we are saying to these 3% that they have achieved the minimum skill needed to square dance.

Whether because we say "everyone can square dance" and therefore it is socially unacceptable not to graduate someone, or because with the decline in square dancing clubs are so desperate for bodies that they will take anyone no matter how bad they are, the result is that people who have no idea what is going on are being told they "belong" and that it is proper for them to be on the dance floor.

EXAMPLE OF THIS. On a recent calling trip I witnessed a new graduate square up in the #3 position and then ask someone: "Is this the head position?" This couple had been dancing seven months and they don't even know where the heads are? You can imagine how this couple did with the calls – it was a disaster.

I have seen people who have been dancing for nine months and have been given a diploma have no idea how to do a Square Thru from the standard position, have no idea what hand to put up for a Star Thru. These people just wander around the square with a blank look and wait for someone to put them in place, which is necessary on almost every call. Of course, they are also moving very slow, so this impacts everyone in the square – even those who are not helping them at the particular moment.

I heard a great description of these people: they are like liquid cement, because you never know where they are going to set up.

Next month we will look at how clubs react to this situation, the impact these 3% have on other dancers, and what the solution is to the problem.
