From the Editor....

I have subscriptions to *Bow & Swing*, *American Square Dance*, *Panhandle Press*, and receive complimentary copies from *Keepin' Posted* and *USDA News*, and it is disconcerting to me why many of the clubs in the West Coast area don't take advantage of the free advertising in *Bow & Swing* and the *West Coast Dancer* by writing articles about their club's activities. These publications list all the club names, and if they haven't received an article, the editors put "No report received this month". Does this mean your club isn't doing anything or that you're not interested in having visitors to your club?

Even in this newsletter, I have difficulty receiving information from several clubs in our area regarding themes, cancellations or changes. This too is free advertising!

Did you know your club can purchase ads in the *Bow & Swing* and the *West Coast Dancer* for a small charge where you can list your schedule, themes, etc.

The 59th Florida State Convention is fast approaching. Life's a Beach in 2013 at the Lakeland Center, May 24 – 26, 2013. For your planning purposes Friday night is designated as Convention Costume Night, and since this is a beach party please dress for that theme. No bathing suits without proper shirts and shorts. For safety reasons, no flip flops or sandals. Saturday night is square dance attire in your club colors and Sunday night is square dance attire in the colors of the next convention which are purple and white. Respectable casual attire is acceptable during the day for the workshops.

There will be a Singles Hall in Sikes F on Friday night only. ANYONE is welcome to dance in this hall and your support is appreciated! This is an opportunity for the solo dancers to meet the

other solos at the convention. There are callers and cuers booked for the entire evening. Please support this hall so we can continue to have it every year. We sometimes have visitors from other states and new dancers who are looking for partners and we need to make them feel welcome. There will be sections marked in every hall for “Dancers without partners”. If you don’t have a partner, please sit in or stand in these sections so the other solo dancers can find you. There will be Solo ribbons at the ticket windows if you want to wear one of them. If you have singles in your club or you know single dancers, please encourage them to attend our convention.

It is again necessary to reduce the square footage of our dancing space at the Lakeland Center which necessitates changes in how we do some things.

On Saturday night there will be a grand march. Because of space constraints only the officers of the Florida Federation, Round Dance Council of Florida, Florida Callers Association, Florida Association of Single Square and Round Dancers (FASSRD), and the Campers, as well as four representatives from each Florida club will be able to participate in the march. All organizations are asked to wear their club colors and carry their club banner.

Everyone is asked to arrive at Exhibition Hall West between 6:00 and 6:30 p.m. for the evening entertainment. All vendors and other dance halls will be closed during this time. You will want to arrive early so you can find a good seat! Line up for the grand march will be in a different area this year so please remain in your seats until you are dismissed to leave the room to get in line. When you arrive at the staging area, please remain quiet so you can hear the instructions.

Are you Dancing Uninsured?

Every square dance organization needs General Liability and Accident Medical Expense coverage while conducting and sponsoring dance activities. As closely as safety rules are followed, accidents can and will happen. This insurance program, especially designed for United Square Dancers of America (USDA) dance groups, provides Accident Medical Insurance, which helps protect club members from financial loss due to a covered accidental bodily injury, and Liability insurance, which protects the club and its members and association officials from financial loss due to unforeseen incidents which may develop into litigation against members and dance organizations.

Liability Insurance

Limits of protection: \$1,000,000 combined single limit of liability for bodily injury and property damage per occurrence (subject to a \$100 property damage deductible per claim) while participating in scheduled and sponsored dancing activities. \$100,000 limit for damage to premises rented to you.

Who is covered: The club and its members while participating in club or organization sponsored and supervised dancing activities. Liability coverage applies in the United States, its territories or possessions, and Canada.

Accident and Medical Insurance

Limits of coverage: \$10,000 Usual and Customary Accident Medical Expense, including Dental \$10,000, Accidental Death Benefit \$10,000, Accidental Dismemberment Benefit (loss of both hands, both feet, sight of both eyes, or any combination thereof), \$5,000 Accidental Dismemberment Benefit (loss of one hand, one foot, sight of one eye).

Note: Coverage is excess to any other valid and collectible medical insurance covering the same accident. Coverage provided for covered medical expenses incurred within 52 weeks of the accident up to \$10,000 for all eligible expenses as stated in the Policy.

Who is covered: Club members will be insured while participating in any regularly scheduled and sponsored dancing activity worldwide, including group travel (10 or more club members) in a vehicle commercially licensed for transportation of passengers and operated by a person holding a valid operator's license for such vehicle, while being transported to or from a covered dancing activity.

What is covered: Accidental bodily injury sustained by an insured person while participating in dancing activities sponsored and supervised by a recognized club or organization.

Period of coverage: The insurance year is January 1 through December 31. Coverage becomes effective for individual clubs under the policy on the day the application and premium for insurance is received by the USDA National Insurance Coordinator. There is no pro-rate provision. This is necessary due to the large administrative expense of maintaining different policy dates.

The current insurance premium is \$4.45 per member. Minimum clubs, 10 members or less, are a flat \$45 per club. There must be 100% participation for each club. Some clubs charge their members the insurance premium or they deduct the cost from the dues.

Editor's Note: If your club does not participate in the USDA Square Dance Insurance Program because you live in a community that has its own insurance coverage, please keep in mind that you are not covered when you leave your community i.e. banner raids and retrievals, demonstrations, etc.
